COMPASSION COMMISSION DRESS CODE

Our goal is to maintain a Christ-honoring environment that reflects modesty, respect, and unity throughout the week. Students are expected to follow the dress code at all times.

Workday Attire (Service Projects)

Students should wear clothing that is appropriate for physical labor and outdoor activities.

Required:

- Old clothes that can get dirty
- Closed-toe shoes or sneakers
- Shorts must reach at least fingertip length when standing naturally
- Compassion T-shirt on Saturday for the Block Party

Not Allowed:

- Tight-fitting tank tops
- Low-cut shirts or tops
- Visible bra straps
- Midriff-baring shirts or clothing that exposes the stomach
- Extremely tight clothing
- Low-rise pants that expose undergarments
- Open-toed shoes, sandals, or flip-flops during work projects

Evening Service Attire

Students will have time to change before evening services and are expected to dress neatly and modestly.

Required:

- Clean, presentable clothing appropriate for church services
- Compassion T-shirt for Thursday evening service

Not Allowed:

- Shorts above the knee
- Tank tops
- Low-cut shirts or tops

- Shirts that expose the midriff or any stomach skin
- Visible bra straps
- Low-hanging pants that expose undergarments
- Ripped jeans or clothing with holes that expose skin
- Skin-tight or excessively form-fitting clothing

General Expectations

- Clothing should be modest and not draw unnecessary attention to the body.
- Low-cut necklines, visible cleavage, exposed midriffs, visible bra straps, and exposed undergarments are not permitted.
- Pants and shorts should fit appropriately and remain securely at the waist.
- Clothing should not be excessively tight or revealing.
- Compassion leadership reserves the right to determine whether clothing is appropriate and may ask a student to change if necessary.
