Fill extraction well with reagent


Insert collection swab and incubate for 1 minute

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Tip device allowing liquid to flow at 10 to 15 minutes

Interpret results at 10 to 15 minutes

Status Flu A & B vs. PCR

	Influenza A	Influenza B
Positive Percent Agreement (PPA)	89.2 % (95% CI: 83.0 - 93.4%)	86.4 % (95% CI: 80.1 - 90.9%)
Negative Percent Agreement (NPA)	99.4 % (95% CI: 97.7 - 99.8%)	99.0 % (95% Cl: 97.1 - 99.7%)
