Lewis & Clark Visitors Center, Nebraska City, NE

The three story, 12,000 square foot, Lewis & Clark Interpretive Center sits on a scenic 79 acre wooded bluff overlooking the Missouri River. An unobstructed view of the river gives today's audience a sense for what greeted the captains 200 years ago. Admission is \$8.00 Adults / \$6.00 Seniors. 100 Valmont Drive, Nebraska City, NE

Civil War Veterans Museum, Nebraska City, NE

At one time, there were more than 100 Grand Army of the Republic Halls in Nebraska. Only four remain today. The Nebraska City G.A.R. Hall, built in 1894, is the only one of these halls in the state that has undergone restoration and development as a Civil War and G.A.R. museum. In addition, it is the only Civil War Museum in Nebraska. Admission is \$3.00. 910 1st Corso, Nebraska City

Sunken Gardens, Lincoln, NE

The only Nebraska garden to be listed in the "300 Best Gardens to Visit in the United States and Canada" by National Geographic's "Guide to Public Gardens", this enchanting place is important to many. Admission is Free. Located at S 27th St & Capitol Pkwy

International Quilt Museum, Lincoln, NE

The International Quilt Museum's mission is to build a global collection and audience that celebrate the cultural and artistic significance of quilts. The museum has the world's largest publicly held quilt collection, dating from the early 1700s to present and representing more than 60 countries. Admission is \$8.00 Adults / \$6.00 Seniors. Located at 1523 N. 33rd St., Lincoln

World's Largest Time Capsule, Seward, NE

In the middle of Seward, Nebraska, you'll find something that is more than just a unique sculpture—it's actually the World's Largest Time Capsule! It came about as a way for businessman, writer and historian Harold Davisson to preserve a snapshot of his life in 1975 for his grandchildren. It includes two different rooms and a massive underground portion, which holds two cars, a motorcycle and a ton of '70s memorabilia. It was sealed and dedicated on July 4, 1975 and is set to be opened 50 years later on July 4, 2025. Location 318 Hillcrest Drive. From I-80 exit 379 - Seward is 6 miles North.
