

As we get ready to kick off the NSRA rodeo season in June, just wanted to share a few updates regarding entries and memberships.

This year, RodeoTrak will be helping us manage entries. If you've entered KPRA or CPRA rodeos before, you're probably already familiar with their system. We're excited to use it and hope it makes the entry process smoother for everyone, especially when it comes to buddy groups.

With the buddy group limit increasing to six people, all mixed team roping teams will need to be entered together with the rest of the contestants and events in that group. Unfortunately, we will no longer be able to match up partners through separate phone calls. If you'd still like to enter mixed team roping without a partner, that's perfectly fine—just make a note when entering, such as "JOE SMITH/NEED HEELER."

A reminder that memberships must be purchased by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday to be considered a member for Wednesday entries. Please remember to add a "N (NSRA), M (M-SRA), K (KPRA) or C (CPRA)" in front of your card numbers so that you won't be entered as a non member (NM). Most membership numbers can be found on their respective websites.

Going forward, **rodeoentries4u.com** will be your one-stop location for all NSRA rodeo entry information. You'll find the online entry link right on the homepage, and day sheets will be posted there as well.

We will continue to have two phone lines available for entries, but we will not be using the rollover feature this year. Please call either number to enter. Also new hours! Wednesdays from 9 am to 2 pm CT and callbacks on Thursday from 9 am – 11 am CT. Day sheets can be found on at [rodeoentries4u.com](http://rodeoentries4u.com). Refresh the page to get the current information.
