

Dear Home Care Organization (HCO) Licensees:

The State Public Health Officer Order issued on December 22, 2021 was updated on January 25, 2022. The deadline for all Registered Home Care Aides and HCO staff with direct contact with clients or prospective clients who are currently eligible for boosters to be fully vaccinated and receive a booster dose for COVID-19 has been extended from February 1, 2022 to March 1, 2022.
