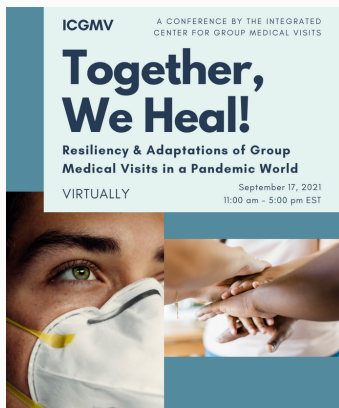
ICGMV has big plans for expanding community programs this coming year and there are a number of ways you can get involved on November 30th:

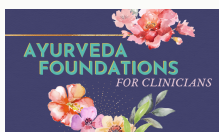
