WHAT'S HAPPENING AT THE CENTER

ICGMV's group space re-opened on June 1st! Thank you to all who joined us for the virtual open house.

With the reopening, group programming officially started both in-person and virtually utilizing the HOoLA model. The day of the opening, the Center started a summer trauma-informed yoga program which offers 7 yoga classes and limited counselling for the community of Lawrence. This program officially goes until mid-September and was made available by the support of the Massachusetts Office for Victim Assistance (MOVA) and the City of Lawrence

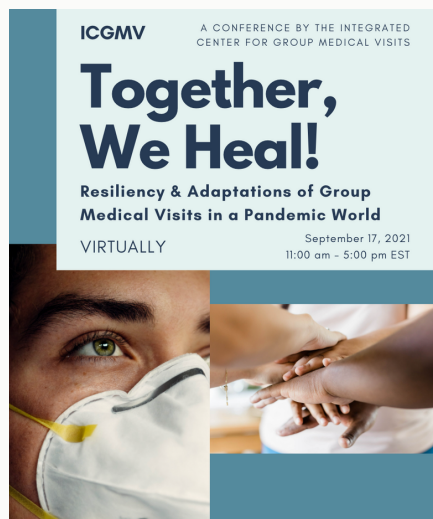
Research Study Expectations:

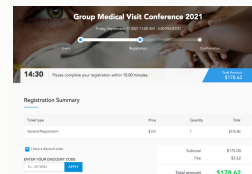
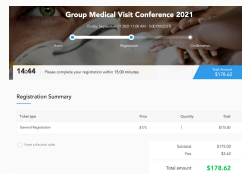
