

Documents Checklist for Canada Tourist Visa from India

1. Application Form

- Completed and signed Visitor Visa (Temporary Resident Visa) application form.

2. Passport:

- Valid passport with at least six months of validity from the planned date of entry into Canada.
- Include all previous passports if applicable.
- Photocopy of the bio-data page of the passport.

3. Photographs:

- Two recent passport-sized photographs as per the photo specifications - 50 mm X 70 mm in size (2 inches wide X 2 3/4 inches long)

4. Proof of Financial Support:

- Bank statements for the last 6 months.
- Proof of income (salary slips, employment letter, tax documents).
- Any other documents demonstrating sufficient funds to cover your stay in Canada (e.g., fixed deposits, property documents).

5. Proof of Employment/Business:

- Employment letter stating your role, salary, and length of employment.
- If self-employed, business registration documents and proof of business activities.
- NOC (No Objection Certificate) from employer, if employed.

6. Travel Itinerary:

- Detailed travel itinerary including flight bookings, accommodation details, and planned activities.

7. Proof of Ties to India:

- Evidence of ties to India, such as property documents, family ties, employment letter, and any other documents showing your intent to return to India after your visit.

8. Invitation Letter (if applicable):

- Invitation letter from friends or family in Canada, if you are visiting them.
- The letter should include the inviter's full name, address, status in Canada, and details of your relationship.

9. Medical Exam (if required):

- Depending on the duration of your stay and your recent travel history, a medical exam may be required.

10. Police Clearance Certificate (if required):

- A police clearance certificate to prove you have no criminal record.

11. Visa Fee Payment:

- Proof of payment of the visa application fee.

12. Cover Letter:

- A cover letter explaining the purpose of your visit, details of your travel, and any other relevant information supporting your application.

Additional Documents

- Proof of previous travel history: Copies of visas and entry/exit stamps to countries you have visited.
- Travel Insurance: Proof of travel insurance covering medical expenses during your stay in Canada.

Submission Process

- Biometrics: Schedule and attend a biometrics appointment to provide your fingerprints and photograph.
- Application Submission: Submit your completed application and supporting documents online or at a Visa Application Centre (VAC).
