The Political Winds Are Changing in Colorado. 🇺🇸

It's official — Democrats are losing ground in Colorado.

According to a 2025 statewide poll by the Colorado Polling Institute (via Axios), Democratic favorability has fallen from 52% to just 39%, while unfavorability jumped to 56%.

At the same time, unaffiliated voters now make up over 50% of Colorado's electorate — meaning most voters no longer identify with either major party.

Add in widespread frustration over the economy and inflation, and it's clear the political mood across our state is shifting. Colorado voters are looking for balance, accountability, and fiscal responsibility — not one-party control.

The "blue stronghold" narrative no longer fits.
Change is in the air. 🇺🇸
