

The 3-year CAGR* for Total Technology Partners stands at 11% compared to 7% CAGR for IT Services companies. Hyperscalers contribute +4% points to the CAGR of the combined technology partners growth.

Q2'24 shows +11% YoY growth for Technology Partners,




significantly outpacing the +1% YoY growth of Top 20 IT Services companies.


The growth trend from Q2'22 to Q3'23 shows a strong correlation between IT Services companies and their key partners. However, since Q3'23, partner growth has surged while IT services growth has stagnated. It will be interesting to see if this will translate into growth for IT services in Q3'24 or Q4'24.

Year-over-Year Revenue Growth by Category


Infra categories at +3%, while all others posted a +10% growth in Q2'24



Over the last 8 quarters, Cyber, Cloud, and Data growth rates have slowed, while the Infra category is rebounding due to AI investments.




Q2'24 YoY Growth by Technology Partner




Reflection on Q-Monitor, IT Services Tech Partners #1:


We will explore expanding the number of areas and partners in future monitors. For example, splitting the CX/ERP category to include Adobe and doubling cybersecurity partners for deeper insights. Initially, we considered adding UIPath and Pega under Data, AI & Automation but opted for Elastic due to better fit into the Data & AI category. Future monitors will also focus more on growth drivers and profitability by category, and acquisitions IT Services companies have made in respective categories.

Q2'24 YoY Growth and 3-Year CAGR by Technology Partner (Data & Al Category)




Q2'24 YoY Growth and 3-Year CAGR by Technology Partner (Customer & Enterprise Apps Category)





Q2'24 YoY Growth and 3-Year CAGR by Technology Partner (Cloud Services)



Appendix: Background

- Top 20 IT Listed IT Services companies Monitor: To track momentum in the global IT services market, and performance across the largest listed firms, we launched a quarterly monitor six months ago. The first editions covered Q1'24 and Q2'24. This monitor offers insights on overall market growth, with a segmentation of trends across industries and geographies.
- What IT Services companies don't disclose in quarterly filings is the detailed performance of specific offerings and technology focus areas. Many only provide broad categories such as Consulting, Technology, Outsourcing, and Other. Our aim is to gain deeper insights into their market performance across these underlying areas.
- Using 6 Key Technology Partners from the Top 20 IT
 Services companies across 5 categories, we track
 quarterly year-on-year growth and 3-year CAGR for both
 sectors and individual partners. This also allows for a
 direct comparison between the growth rates of the Top
 20 Global IT Services market and their key technology
 partners.
- This report references Calendar Quarter Q2'24 (April to June 2024). For companies with differing reporting periods, the selected period includes at least two months that align with the Q2'24 timeframe.
