## FRIENDLY ANNEXATION PROCEDURE

Applicant: please keep this page for your records

- 1. Submit petition for annexation
  - a. Must be signed by all property owners
  - b. Must be notarized
  - c. Must attach a legal land description of the property and label it "Exhibit A"
- 2. After petition is received, a Notice of Public Hearing will be ran in The Banner Press, setting forth the property to be annexed, and the date and time of the public hearing. (The property owner requesting the annexation is responsible for the cost of the publication in the Banner Press.)
  - a. There must be a time period of at least seven (7) days after the Public Hearing is published before the hearing can be held.
- 3. After the hearing is held, there must be at least a 14 day waiting period, before an Ordinance can be passed to annex the property
  - a. After the 14 day waiting period, if no objections have been filed, as a special meeting, or as a part of a regular meeting an Ordinance will be passed to annex the property.
- 4. The City has 60 days from the date the Petition is signed to get the necessary notices and hearings held and the ordinance entered. If this time frame is not met, the City must obtain a new Petition and start all over.
