About Latina Equal Pay Day

Latinas are one of the fastest-growing, most powerful groups in the United States. Latinas excel in every sector and industry in our country. Despite all of this, in 2024, Latinas continued to face a pay gap that is, on average, an abysmal 54 cents to every dollar paid to white, non-Hispanic men. This number includes all Latinas with reported earnings, like part-time, seasonal, and migrant workers. For full-time, year-round workers, the pay gap is 58 cents for every dollar paid to white, non-Hispanic men.




