## ACS and SBC Unite for Syria: A Call to Action for Reconstruction and Justice

Damascus, Syria – December 23, 2024 The American Coalition for Syria (ACS) and the Syrian British Consortium (SBC) held a historic press conference in Damascus yesterday, December 22nd, marking a pivotal moment for Syria's future. The event brought together Syrian-American and Syrian-British leaders, expatriates, and local officials to discuss the role of the Syrian diaspora in humanitarian efforts, stabilization, investment, and rebuilding the nation's democratic foundations.

As Americans, we extend our hands in congratulations and support to the Syrian people, who have endured so much to reach this moment. This freedom came at a great cost but is a monumental achievement."

The conference also provided a platform for discussing transitional justice, national reconciliation, and reconstruction strategies. Participants reiterated their commitment to justice and human rights, calling upon the international community to support this critical rebuilding phase.

This event underscores the collective resolve of Syrians across the globe to overcome the challenges ahead and build a nation grounded in freedom, equality, and justice. As both ACS and SBC reaffirmed, the path to a brighter future is paved by unity, resilience, and unwavering commitment to the principles of the Syrian Revolution.
