To Whom It May Concern,

James McQueeney is a 31 year old male with HLA-B27 associated iritis OU since 10/2013. Symptoms of inflammatory flares include eye pain, redness, photophobia, blurred vision, halos around light, floaters and photopsia.

We evaluated this patient at MERSI on [REDACTED] 17, and there was no inflammation on exam at that time. His last documented flare at our office was OD [REDACTED] 16. He was doing well on immunomodulatory therapy, but he decided on his own to discontinue both Humira 40mg (every 2 weeks) and Cellcept 500mg per day in [REDACTED] /2016. We evaluated him again on [REDACTED] /2017 and found him to have a flare of ocular inflammation again. In my years of experience, various factors are known to contribute to inflammation including stress, trauma, and changes in medication.
