Ace Hardware is moving into
the former 99 Cents location
before the end of the year.

Three businesses will be moving into the old Goodwill building, including a Claw King arcade (using a mechanical claw to grab a stuffed animal), Truewin Restaurant serving Boba and coffee, and Tang Bao Restaurant serving casual Asian food like noodles and steamed buns. Lewelling Boulevard Bikeway

This project will include complete street improvements on Lewelling Boulevard between Wicks Boulevard and Washington Avenue, including bikeways with physical barriers, new curb ramps, bulb-outs, enhanced crosswalk markings, signage and striping. You can voice your concerns through the Spring of 2027 as the City continues to refine the design.

gram and Linkedin providing tips and education on holiday waste sorting and proper disposal of fat, oil and grease.

**Point of Sale Sewer Lateral will be required at the sale of your house starting in July, 2026, if the test shows that you have a leak in your sewer lateral. This will help reduce the demand on the sewage treatment plant during storms (stop inflow of rain water through broken sewer laterals) and protect the environment (stop outflow of sewage into people's yards year round from broken laterals).

**The Oro Loma Sanitary District uses smart trucks to collect your

garbage and recyclables. Smart trucks use technology that can photograph overfilled garbage containers and contaminated recycle bins that can result in warning letters and fines for multiple offenders. The good news is that there is only a 2-3% contamination rate among residential customers. To obtain more information about the topics listed above, visit https://oroloma.org.


