<u>Diving</u>

The Florida Keys are a paradise for diving, especially for new or infrequent visitors. It is easy, the water is warm (the Average Temperature is 81.5F), and visibility is excellent. All of it is Boat Diving.

I plan to dive 2-10 times over the course of the week.

If you want to get **Dive Certified**, please let me know. There are three general ways to do it.

- 1. Work with your local dive shop. They can certify you in your location.
- 2. Work with your local dive shop for course and pool work and get a referral for checkout Dives in the keys. I can give you the names of the shops I recommend.
- 3. If you are willing to come to FL a little earlier, I do have a friend who is an instructor and is willing to help get people certified.

If you don't want to dive, snorkeling is just as good. PLUS, some boats are combo diving snorkel boats, so that is a fun group activity.
