

Sailboat Trip Packing List

You will be on a 42-47' Catamaran sailboat with many luxuries. Still, high-energy items like hair dryers, curling/flat irons, and beard trimmers only work on generator power and are unnecessary.

You will also be going ashore in a small dinghy, which means climbing up and down the boat pontoons and off the docks, shorter dresses are better than longer ones. It will be hot during the day, a little cooler in the evening, and the occasional pop-up shower. The restaurants are casual dress.

Please do not bring Perfumes or Cologne, they attract mosquitos (bug spray will be available on the boat). We also ask that you pack in a soft-sided bag, they store easily on the boat.

Electronics (*we will have internet on the board, but it is not strong, and won't stream, but it is good to post to Facebook, check email, etc.*)

- o Camera
- o Flash Drive (*we will aggregate all the pictures before we leave so you have a full complement to document your trip*)
- o Music (*the boat will have an auxiliary plug*)
- o Chargers
- o Technology (*Water and Electronics do not mix, so phones, iPads, and Kindles should be kept in a zip lock bag or wet dry bag when moving on and off the boat.*)

SHOES

- o Sandals / Flip Flops
- o White Sole Shoes (*or go barefoot on the boat, dark ones mark the deck*)

PROTECTION FROM ELEMENTS

- o Sunscreen
- o Hat & Buffs/Scarf (*keep the hair back*)
- o Sunglasses & Strap (*you don't want them to fly overboard*)

CLOTHING (*You do not need much / Space is limited/ We live mostly in swimsuits, dry fit and moisture wicking are best*)

- o 2-3 Swimsuits
- o 2-3 Shorts (*2-3 for Boat and 1 for Shore Visits*)
- o 3-4 Tee-Shirts/Tank Tops
- o Polo/Shorts/for Dinner on Shore
- o Short Sun Dress (*you will be getting in and out of a dinghy*) for Dinner on Shore
- o Swim Cover-up
- o 1-2 Sun Shirts
- o Long sleeve shirt or Sweatshirt (*cool evenings*)
- o Lightweight Rain Jacket (*the occasional squall*)

- o Beach Towel (*bath towels will be provided*)
- o Personals (*underwear / Bras*)

OTHER

- o Small Backpack or Purse to Take Ashore
- o Books (*Kindle/Ipads are best, because books are heavy*)
- o Ear Plugs / Mask (*if we need to run AC and Generator*)
- o Sea Sickness pills (*if needed*)
- o Plastic Refillable Water Bottle

TOILETRIES (*Marine Safe Toiletries will be Provided (Stream2Sea)*)

- o Razor
- o Deodorant
- o Toothbrush / Toothpaste
- o Other personal items you need
- o Prescription Medicine (*we keep a full first aid kit with us*)
