HTRC's Show Rules

- 1. This is an official A.R.B.A. Open and Youth sanctioned show. By submitting an entry, you have indicated that you will abide by HTRC's show rules and the rules of the A.R.B.A., which govern this show.
- 2. <u>ARBA Show Rule 30</u>, All animals must be the property of the exhibitor(s) prior to entry. Each owner's personal name(s) must be listed on the entry form.
- 3. No animals under $\underline{10 \text{ weeks}}$ of age will be allowed in the barn for any HTRC event.
- 4. HTRC will not accept day of show entries. This includes moving rabbits to different classes.
- 5. All shows will start promptly at 9AM.
- 6. HTRC will allow you to still enter for the shows Friday evening from 6:30pm to 8:30pm. You will need to do your own paperwork entry form and comment cards. Turn paperwork into show secretary before 8pm.
- 7. Make checks payable to High Time Rabbit Club (H.T.R.C.) Make sure your entry form is completely filled out, if you have questions, please call the show secretaries. Email entries to <a href="https://highen.com/hightimerabbitclub.com/hightimerabbitcl
- 8. HTRC's rabbit/cavy events: email or online entries will be accepted until 11:59 PM on Monday Sept 4th 2023.
- 9. All entries will need to be paid for even if you do not attend or you scratch rabbits at the show.
- 10. All entries must be paid before the start of the show. There will be a \$35.00 charge for all NSF checks. You will not be able to show in upcoming events till all fees are paid.
- 11. Judging order will be posted Friday night but judging order may need to be rearranged.
- 12. Youth show is for any youth between the ages of 5 and 18 years old. Youth cannot enter the same rabbit in the Open All Breed show if they are showing the same rabbit in the Youth All Breed Show. Youth will need to handle their own animals and be able to get their rabbits to and from the show tables. Nobody over the age of 19 years old can show in a Youth Show.
- 13. All rabbits must have A PERMANENT, LEGIBLE TATTOO IN THE LEFT EAR or they could be eliminated.
- 14. All wool/fur entries must be entered in their breed class. Unless another fur class is requested, all fur entries will be judged in breed fur.
- 15. Exhibitors will be responsible for getting their rabbits to the judging table as soon as the class is called. Rabbits will be called three times. If they are not on the table after the third call, the class will be closed. THERE WILL BE NO REJUDGING OF A CLASS.
- 16. Ear number substitutions will be allowed at the show table when the class is called. Please let the helper behind the table for your class know of your ear number change at the time you put your rabbit in the judging coop otherwise you may have your rabbit disqualified. Substitutions may be made only in the same Breed, Variety, Class, and Sex. Please do not ask to change classes for different varieties or sex etc., this would be considered a new entry and HTRC is not allowing day of show entries. Wool/Fur substitutions will be allowed only in the same breed and variety.
- 17. H.T.R.C. reserves the right to add or substitute judges, if necessary. There will be no payback for this show. HTRC ribbons will be awarded to 3rd place. Please pick up your comment cards at the show table they will not be mailed.
- 18. DO NOT enter any other buildings on the fair grounds. Please keep track of your children. Anybody caught vandalizing property will be asked to leave and your entry fees and placing will be forfeited. You will be liable for the cost of repairs. Parking is allowed only in designated areas
- 19. NO SMOKING WILL BE ALLOWED IN ANY OF THE BUILDING! If you do smoke, please pick up your cigarette butts when finished with your cigarettes!! This would be greatly appreciated!!! HTRC members must clean up after you. So please be considerate and pick up your butts.
- 20. HTRC members are required to clean the barn and surrounding areas after the show is over and we would appreciate your help in cleaning your area when finished showing.
- 21. Neither the H.T.R.C. nor the owner, agent, management, of the show facility, or any other organization will be responsible for any type of theft, accident, or injury to any person or personal property, (whether owned, borrowed, or rented) due to neglect or any other cause. Exhibitors will show at their own risk. Parents are responsible for their children and their actions.

The State of Wyoming requires a health Certificate for any animal coming into the State of Wyoming. HTRC will not need to see the health Certificates.

New Location - Building M/K Directions to Archer Event Center

<u>FROM I-25</u> Head East on I-80 (approx 8 miles East from I-25/I-80 intersection) Take Exit 370, turn Right (head South) onto Archer Parkway. Continue straight thru the roundabout take the 1^{st} left entrance onto the fairgrounds. M/K building is 1^{st} building on the right.

<u>From I-80 West</u> Take Exit 370, turn Right (head South) onto Archer Parkway. Continue straight thru the roundabout take the 1st left entrance onto the fairgrounds.

<u>FROM I-80 East Take</u> exit 370 and turn left (head South) onto Archer Parkway. Continue straight thru the roundabout take 1^{st} left entrance onto the fairgrounds.

Once you unload, please move your car to one of the parking lots. Please do not park next to the building this is reserved for Handicap parking.



Friday Night Barn Hours

Barn will be open for anybody wishing to come in Friday evening 5:00pm to 8:30pm. This is a <u>secure</u> building and will be locked after 8:30pm. Campers are welcome but you will need to Dry Camp - no camping outlets available.

Tables will be provided for you to set your rabbit carries on.

Can still Register for HTRC/WSRCA show Friday evening

If you missed the entry deadline you may still enter the HTRC events Friday evening. Be prepared to fill out your own comment cards and entry forms, if entering your breed's wool/fur class, you will also need to fill out a separate comment card for this class.

All paperwork must be turned in by 8pm Friday.

No entries will be accepted Saturday, the day of show, and no class changes will be allowed. No exceptions, so please do not ask!!
