Directions to this location is in the catalog. This is a secure and temperature control building with a cement floor. Barn will be open Friday evening 6pm to 8pm. Saturday morning 7am.

If Show is canceled due to RVHD2 in our area any money paid for entries will be completely refund. If HTRC must cancel your entry due to RVHD2 being in your area, after submitting your entry fees, a refund will be given back to you.

ARBA Rule Section 15/D: HTRC must refuse entries from all locations within 50 miles of a domestic rabbit case/25 miles for a feral or wild rabbit which has had a confirmed outbreak of RCD/RHD/VHD/RVHD2 within the past 30 days of the entry.

HTRC/WSRCA events are a **pre - entry** show

You need to pre-enter your rabbits by doing one of the following types of entries
- email, online entry or calling your entry to the show secretary.

Comment cards will already be filled out for you.

You will not need to fill them out.

No Mail in entries.

Call-ins, Email or Online entries are due no later than
Tuesday Sept 6th, 2022 by 11:59pm

Please remember if doing entry by email or Online and you are not able to attend you are still required to pay for your entry.

You can now fill out your entry form and pay for entries online, go to www.hightimerabbitclub.com and click on Online Entry tab. HTRC's entries will need to be paid before the show starts Saturday morning.

***Show Reports and ARBA leg Certificates will be emailed unless otherwise stated with your entry.

HTRC's Show Rules

1. This is an official A.R.B.A. Open and Youth sanctioned show. By submitting an entry, you have indicated that you will abide by HTRC's show rules and the rules of the A.R.B.A., which govern this show.
2. HTRC reserves the right to refuse entries from all locations within 30 miles for wild/50 miles domestic rabbits which has had a confirmed outbreak of RCD/RHD/VHD within the past 30 days of the entry.
3. **ARBA Show Rule 30.** All animals must be the bonafide property of the exhibitor(s) prior to entry. Each owner's personal name(s) must be listed on the entry form.
4. **No animals under 10 weeks of age will be allowed in the barn for any HTRC event.**
5. **HTRC will not accept day of show entries. This includes moving rabbits to different classes.**
6. HTRC All Breed Shows starts promptly at 9AM.
7. HTRC will allow you to still enter for the shows Friday evening from 6:30pm to 7:45pm. You will need to do your own paperwork - entry form and comment cards. Turn into show secretary before 7:45pm.
8. Make checks payable to High Time Rabbit Club (H.T.R.C.) Make sure your entry form is completely filled out, if you have questions please call the show secretary. Email entries to hiddenlops@rtconnect.net, Call-in entries to 307-547-9247. Online entries can be made thru www.hightimerabbitclub.com
9. HTRC's rabbit events: **Call-ins, email or online entries will be accepted until 11:59 PM on Tuesday Sept 6th 2022.**
10. **All entries will need to be paid for even if you do not attend or you scratch rabbits at the show.** All entries must be paid before the start of the show. There will be a \$35.00 charge for all NSF checks. You will not be able to show in upcoming events till all fees are paid.
11. **HTRC's Rabbit show entry fees: All entry fees are per rabbit/cavy per show Open or Youth \$4.00. Fur classes \$2.50**
12. **WSRCA show Entries: All entry fees are per rabbit/cavy per Open or Youth \$4.00, Fur Classes \$2.50, WSCRA Members \$3.50 Open or Youth, Fur \$2.00**
13. Judging order will be posted Friday night but judging order may need to be rearranged.
14. Youth show is for any youth between the ages of 5 and 18 years old. **Youth cannot enter the same rabbit in the Open All Breed show if they are showing the same rabbit in the Youth All Breed Show. Youth will need to handle their own animals and be able to get their rabbits to and from the show tables. Nobody over the age of 19 years old can show in a Youth Show.**
15. All rabbits must have **A PERMANENT, LEGIBLE TATTOO IN THE LEFT EAR** or they could be eliminated.
16. All fur entries must be entered in their breed class. Unless another fur class is requested, all fur entries will be judged in breed fur.
17. Exhibitors will be responsible for getting their rabbits to the judging table as soon as the class is called. Rabbits will be called three times. If they are not on the table after the third call, the class will be closed. THERE WILL BE NO REJUDGING OF A CLASS.
18. Ear number substitutions will be done at the show table when the class is called. **Please let the helper behind the table for your class know of your ear number change at the time you put your rabbit in the judging coop otherwise you may have your rabbit disqualified.** **Substitutions may be made only in the same Breed, Variety, Class, and Sex. Please do not ask to change classes for different varieties or sex etc., this would be considered a new entry and we are not allowing day of show entries.** Fur substitutions will be allowed only in the same breed and variety.
19. H.T.R.C. reserves the right to add or substitute judges, if necessary. There will be no payback for this show. HTRC ribbons will be awarded to 3rd place. Please pick up your comment cards at the show table they will not be mailed.
20. DO NOT enter any other buildings on the fair grounds. Please keep track of your children. Anybody caught vandalizing property will be asked to leave and your entry fees and placing will be forfeited. You will be liable for the cost of repairs. Parking is allowed only in designated areas
21. **NO SMOKING WILL BE ALLOWED IN ANY OF THE BUILDING! If you do smoke, please pick up your cigarette butts when finished with your cigarettes!! This would be greatly appreciated!!! HTRC members must clean up after you. So please be considerate and pick up your butts.**
22. **HTRC members are required to clean the barn and surrounding areas after the show is over and we would appreciate your help in cleaning your area when finished showing.**
23. Neither the H.T.R.C. nor the owner, agent, management, of the show facility, or any other organization will be responsible for any type of theft, accident, or injury to any person or personal property, (whether owned, borrowed, or rented) due to neglect or any other cause. Exhibitors will show at their own risk. Parents are responsible for their children and their actions.

Directions to Archer Event Center

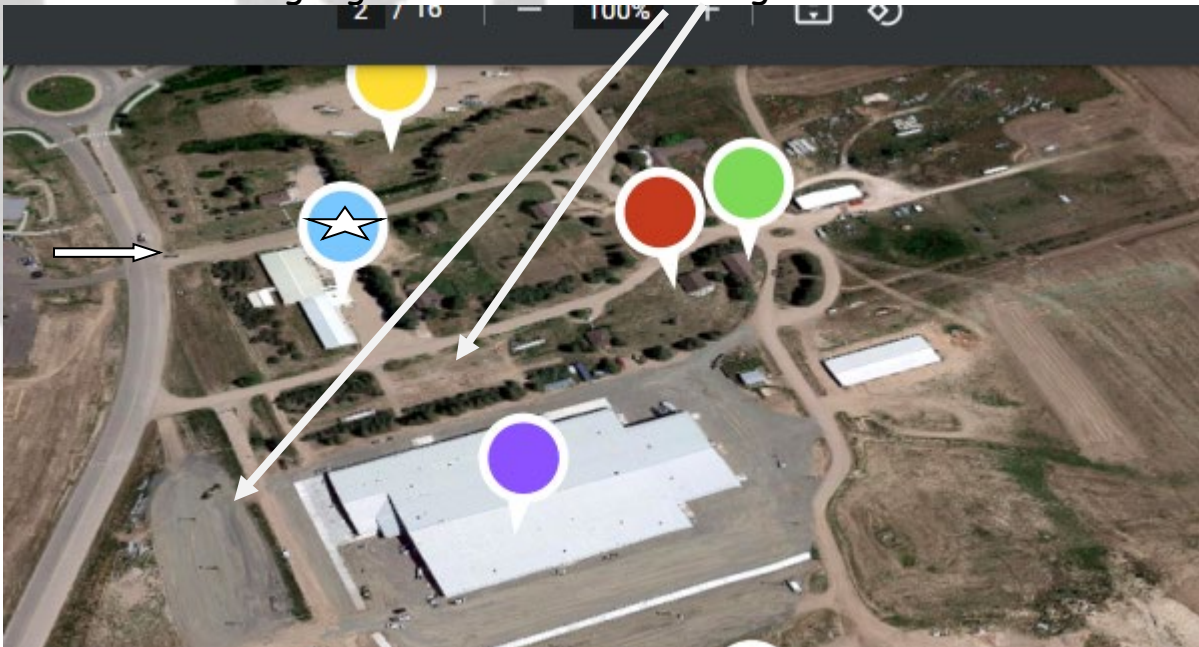
FROM I-25 Head East on I-80 (approx 8 miles East from I-25/I-80 intersection) Take Exit 370, turn Right (head South) onto Archer Parkway. Continue straight thru the roundabout take the 1st left entrance onto the fairgrounds. M/K building is 1st building on the right.

From I-80 West Take Exit 370, turn Right (head South) onto Archer Parkway. Continue straight thru the roundabout take the 1st left entrance onto the fairgrounds.

FROM I-80 East Take exit 370 and turn left (head South) onto Archer Parkway. Continue straight thru the roundabout take 1st left entrance onto the fairgrounds.

Once you unload, please move your car to one of the parking lots. Please do not park next to the building.

WSRCA State Convention Youth Events:

9/10/2022 Archer Event Center, Building M/K

Showmanship:

Youth will compete in three age divisions (Junior, Intermediate, and Senior) and be scored using the ARBA Showmanship Score Sheet used for youth contests at ARBA National Convention. Youth may participate with either a rabbit or a cavy.

Breed Identification:

In the Breed ID contest youth will compete in three age divisions (Junior, Intermediate, and Senior). During the Breed ID competition, youth will identify the Breed, Showroom Variety, Class, and Registration Variety of 25 rabbits or cavies. The youth will be scored using the same system and official Breed ID guide used for the youth contests at ARBA National Convention. The Breed ID Guide can be found at the ARBA Youth Portal <https://arba.net/youth-contests/>. For this contest, youth will be allowed to use their Standard of Perfection and be able to talk to the breeders. This is great practice for learning your rabbit and cavy breeds and varieties.

Poster Contest

Youth may bring an education display, game, or poster. Entries should follow the rules below. Exhibits must include a rabbit or cavy as part of their design and be informational or promotional of either rabbits or cavies. Displays must be mounted on a tri-fold board or a self-supporting display board with items arranged for viewing in front. The display board should provide information regarding the item(s) on display. (ie: medicine kit on display with information on board) Games MUST include play instructions. Posters shall be a single sheet poster board or foam board, overall size should be 22"x28". Any other size will receive a point penalty.

We encourage all youth attending State Convention to try the youth contests. Youth may register for the events on the day of the show.
