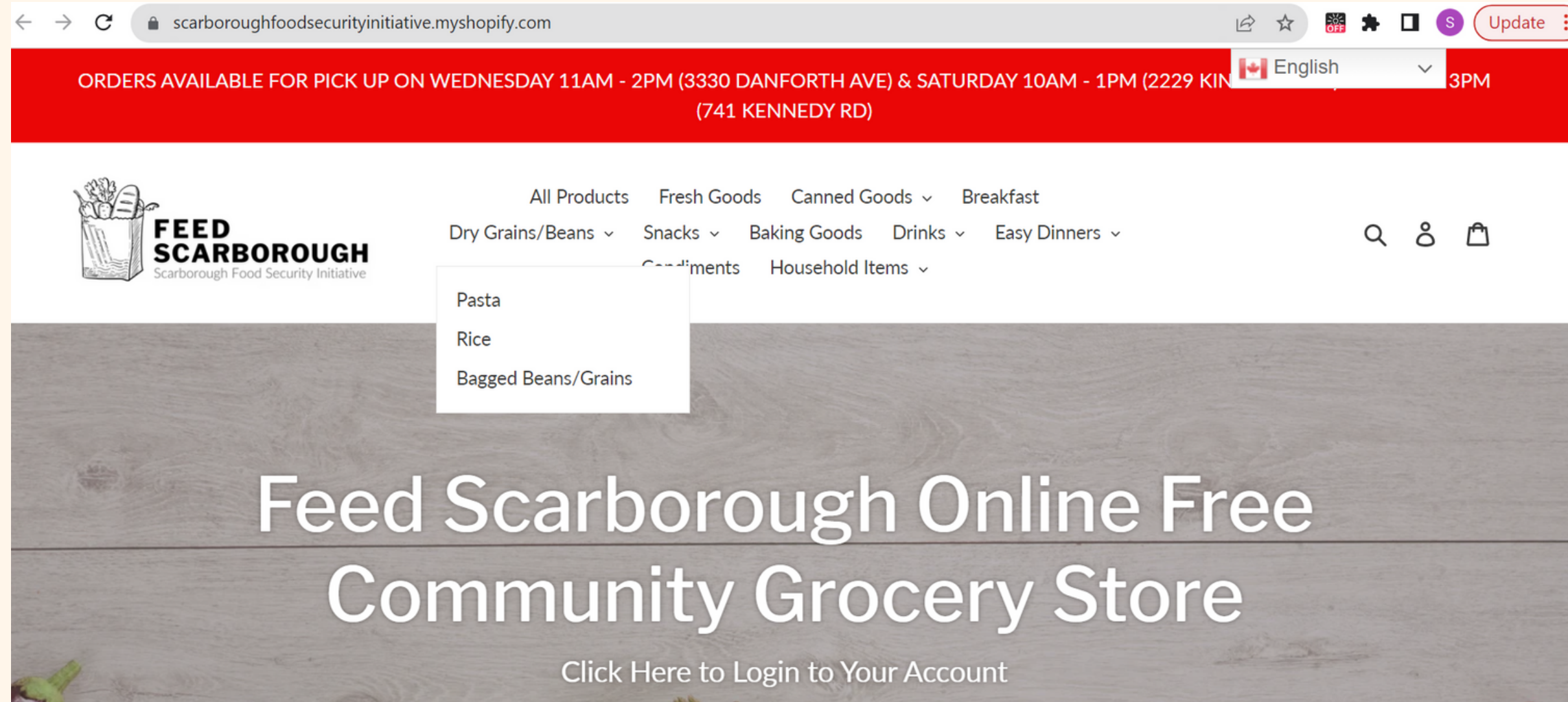

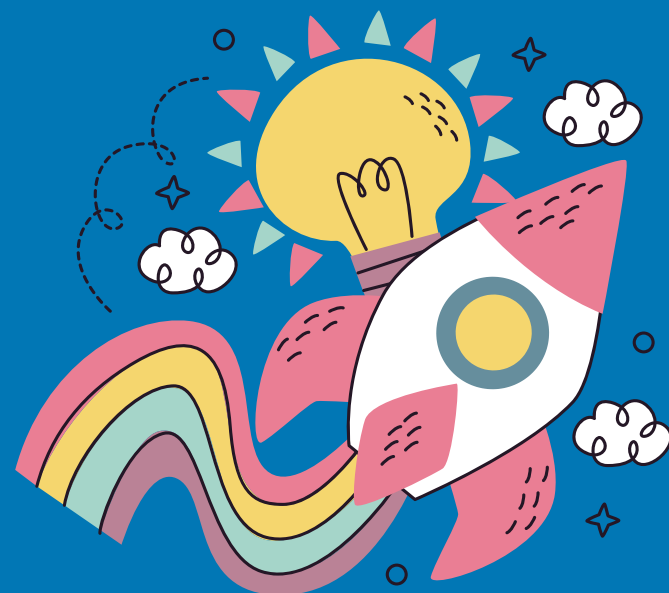

- Glen Everest Community Garden - based on allotment system

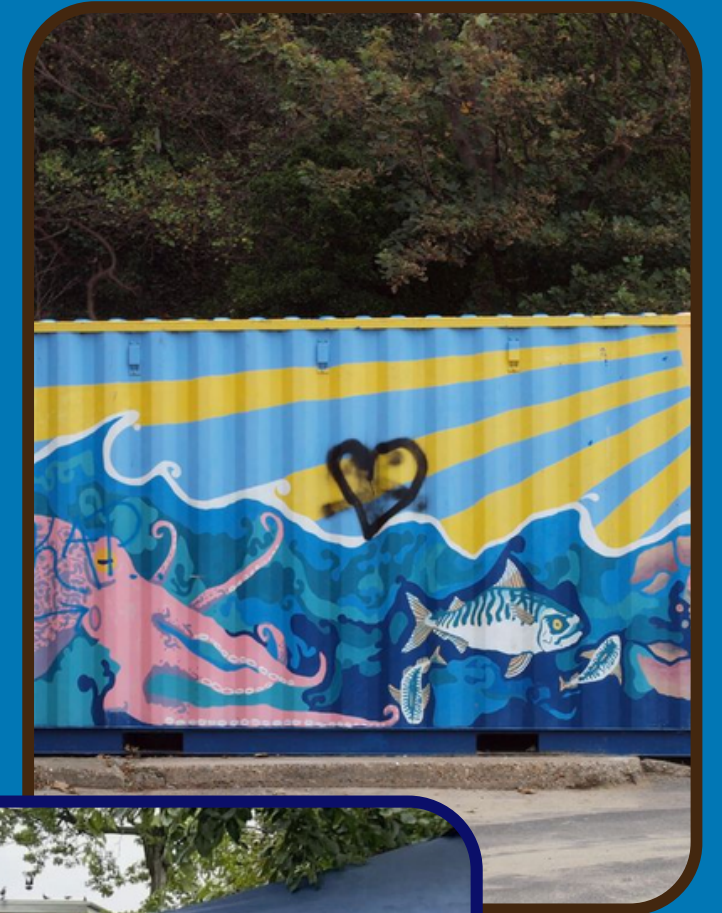
pollinator garden, compost program, diversity (30 crops+), bee hives, seed saving program, workshops, trainings, youth programs etc

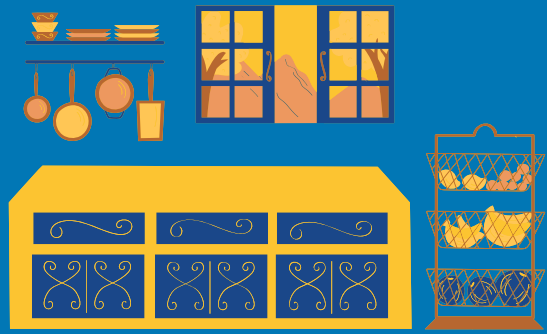

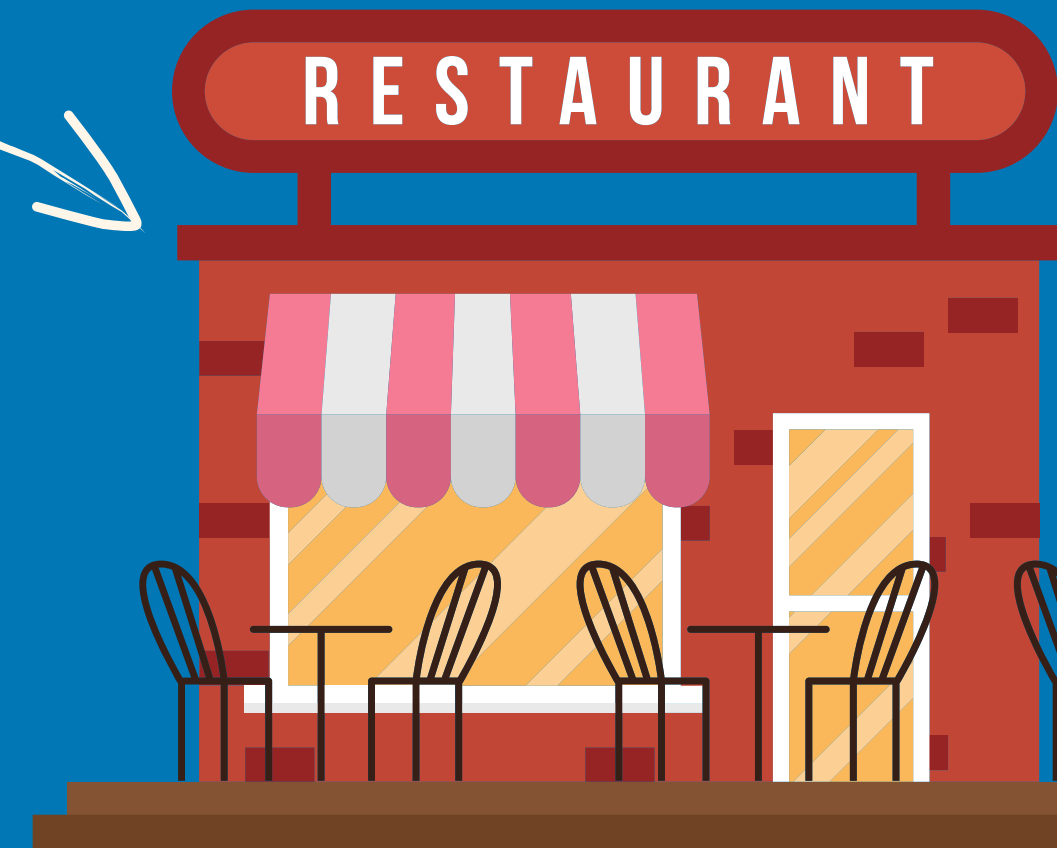

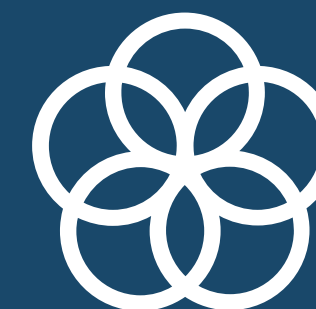
