Bicycle / Skateboarding Policy

The following shall be the policy of the Dighton Housing Authority (DHA):

-No one is allowed to ride a bicycle or skateboard on the sidewalks of Lincoln Village.

-Guests, visitors, homemakers, etc. that are not listed on a DHA Lease are not allowed to ride a bicycle or skateboard anywhere on the grounds of Lincoln Village without written permission from the DHA.

-DHA Residents may ride, at their own risk, a bicycle or skateboard on the main roadway of Lincoln Village.

-The DHA has no inside storage area. It is up to the Resident to store the bicycle/skateboard in their apartment or at a friend/relatives house. DHA will grant written permission to store a bicycle outside behind the Community Center at your own risk. DHA takes zero responsibility for your property or if it gets damaged due to vandalism, weather, etc. If you would like to get permission to store your bike outside, put your request in writing and bring it to the DHA Office. All residents granted written permission will be given a sticker to put on your bicycle that must remain on the bike while stored outside at Lincoln Village.
