

**Dighton Housing Authority
Reasonable Accommodation Policy**

It is the policy of the Dighton Housing Authority (DHA) to not discriminate against persons with disabilities in any way, shape or form. Within reason, it is the intent of the DHA to accommodate the needs of individuals, whether they be existing tenants, employees, program participants, or applicant for tenancy, employment and/or program participation.

It is the policy of the DHA to provide reasonable accommodations to all individuals with disabilities unless the accommodation would present an undue hardship and/or unreasonable financial burden to the authority or alter the nature of the program. In such cases where a request for reasonable accommodations may present an undo hardship or financial burden for the Authority, the DHA will attempt to propose alternate solutions and/or accommodations which do not create a hardship.
