



RIDER'S MEETING



This **IS** the rider's meeting for RMX Championship Series. Please read the information and become familiar with it. **There will be no verbal rider's meeting before motos begin.** If you have any questions or need clarification, please contact the race office. Complete Rule Book can be found at RMXSeries.com

All AMA Amateur Racing rules apply unless otherwise noted as a Supplemental Rule.

SUPPLEMENTAL RULE:

A: MACHINE ELIGIBILITY:

A rider may change motorcycles for each race, with advance approval by the referee

Changing motorcycles during an active race is prohibited.

It is your responsibility to verify your machine is eligible in each class you enter.

RIDER'S MEETING/ADDITIONAL NOTES

1. SPECTATORS/MECHANICS

All spectators, parents, mechanics, etc. must remain behind the fence line or in the designated mechanics/spectator areas at all times. Penalties and/or disqualifications may be enforced.

2. VERIFY YOUR INFORMATION: A complete list of registered riders will be posted on the information board prior to Moto 1. It the rider's responsible to make sure you are entered correctly before racing begins.

We may also post messages if we have a question or an issue with your registration

3. REFUNDS : Refunds will not be given after practice begins.

4. BIKE #'s: LEGIBLE BIKE NUMBERS ARE REQUIRED ON ALL 3 NUMBER PLATES (front and 2 sides).

If this requirement is not met it may result in no score.

5. OFFICIAL FLAGS:

Green – Start of Race

Yellow Flag/Flashing Lights – Danger on Track. Competitors must ride cautiously until they have passed the incident that caused the flag. There is s no passing or gaining an advantage and jumps must be rolled between the flag and the incident that caused the yellow flag. Failure to do so will result in loss of five positions or disqualification, subject to the referee's discretion

Red Cross Flag/Red Lights– Danger on Track. Use **EXTREME CAUTION**

Competitors must ride with extreme caution until they have passed the incident that caused the flag. There is no passing or gaining an advantage and jumps must be rolled between the flag and the incident that caused the red cross flag. Failure to do so will result in loss of 10 positions or a disqualification, subject to the referee's discretion

White – Courtesy Flay: One lap remaining.

Black – Disqualification of rider – rider must immediately leave the track and report to an official.

Red – Stopping of race for any emergency, may require restart of race.

Black & White Checkered – Finish, end of race.

6. SCORING: Scoring concerns should be addressed in writing with the race office within 30 minutes of results being posted.

7. PROTESTS: Protests or concerns should be submitted in writing through the race office. Verbal protests will not be accepted. Written protests are required to be submitted within 30 min of results being posted.

8. RACE AWARDS: See Results Board

9. PRO PAY/BACK: See race office or RMXSERIES.com for pay-out

10. PRACTICE & RACE ORDER: See Handout
