"There is a compelling passion in every artist's soul that feeds on creative expression and a sense of one's self. Seeking the right subject matter to paint seems to be an ongoing quest for most artists. Painting endangered animals seems to be mine. It just 'Feels Right.' The African lion is disappearing from the wild at an alarming rate. There are only about 20,000 left, versus over 200,000 just over a hundred years ago. They are now extinct in 26 African countries. In just the last 20 years the population has plummeted 43 percent. Illegal hunts, poaching, overexploitation, and retaliatory kills are the major contributors to this sad decline. My inspiration for Predator was to show the strength and quiet beauty of this magnificent animal, that hopefully, will never be lost.

As this was my 2nd revision of my original painting, I feel I have achieved what I was searching for. If you can't completely walk away from a painting that you have finished, take another look. If it doesn't feel right, stav with it until it does. You are the creator. Youand only you—know when it's finished. My portfolio and commissioned works of art include portraits, wildlife and nature, cartoons, and illustrations for children's short stories that I also write. My background in art includes graphite, pen and ink, charcoal, pastel, and acrylic mediums. Acrylic painting and children's stories are my passion! It gives me the ability and freedom to create 'Moment to Moment' endlessly. Being able to start and stop spontaneously, or when time permits, is a great thing in today's hectic world. There is such a sense of total expressiveness in each brush stroke, or word on the page of a story, that it is difficult for me to compare it to other forms of art. Painting and writing simply make for a great day."


