






















Meet Rosalie Trulli Vaccaro,

"I should have been an accountant! Yes, I could have been an accountant! Numbers are safe. 2+2 always =4! Life would be safe with numbers. I was good at math - yes siree.

"Instead, I've always had a passion to draw and paint."

She has a BFA plus 2 years and studied with some top master artists as well at the Florence Academy in Italy. Lots of study; lots of workshops!



"Painting is not safe: not like numbers. Each painting you do uses a combination of all your skills and knowledge applied to a canvas or panel. Skills like composition, color, value and your subject matter. Imagining and expressing exactly what you have in mind for this painting to progress, brush stroke by brush stroke. Often it works too! That's when you win!

Many paintings and shows have made me persevere more, not less. A goal of reaching the next rung on a ladder is within your reach. I've been successful as a mother, a graphic designer, camera person and held many jobs in publishing and print, but my passion is and always will be painting.




