Foreword

What would happen if you intertwined the souls of Langston Hughes and Tupac Shakur? What would the outcome be? Would this supernatural merger create another revolutionary author/guerrilla leader—like Ernesto "Che" Guevara? Perhaps—another poetically inclined genius like Jay-Z, whose revolutionary ideals and poetic philosophy influenced the minds of the masses when he said, “*Rosa Parks sat so Martin Luther King could walk. Martin Luther King walked so Obama could run. Obama's running so we all can fly.*” And flying beyond the boundaries of worldly limitations is exactly what you can expect from “*C'est La Vie,*” a collection of pure thoughts and emotions that were captured and recorded in the mind of an offspring of early hip-hop and beat poetry (*a movement that evolved during the 1940s in both New York City and on the west coast*)—his name—Chea—an old soul that's occupying the temple of a young man's body. Chea's poetry—or his opinions on life—touches on evergreen subject matters that we all can relate to—like love and hatred, struggles, successes, and failures, and most importantly—being young, black, and gifted in the midst of white supremacy. But Chea's story is no different than any other African-American poet—like

Langston Hughes, Tupac Shakur, Imamu Amiri Baraka, Maya Angelou, and Nikki Giovanni to name a few; but his youthfulness gives him a present-day advantage to paint a new portrait of urban life in America after 9/11, and even though Kendrick's poems aren't as revolutionary, and—quote-unquote—“we're black and we're proud” as poetry from the 60s, soulfully dynamic and bluesy as poems of the 70s and 80s, or even as down-right raw like poetry from the 90s; it is a perfect representation of what is happening now in America! Let's face it—times have changed, and no longer are our injustices shoved in our faces like back in the day—now it's hidden behind closed doors.

But Chea, unlike most of his peers, chose to remain remotely close to the ideals of those poets who came before him, and in all honesty—through “*C'est La Vie*” He poetically carries the rhythmic torch of beat poetry—during a time when the poetic landscape or playing field seems leveled—making the progress to achieving equality—more mental now than it has ever been; and when Chea writes, “Growing up in my household, it was mandatory to have a book in your hand”, he's telling you the honest truth—that reading is

fundamental because it funds the mental with resources needed to react appropriately to situations that you are facing. There's nothing new under the sun, and each generation has its own obstacles to overcome—and each generation has its own artists—and through various mediums—these artists voice the blueprint on how to overcome our daily difficulties or sufferings—even if they have an audience or not. Because oftentimes—words trapped in a book go unread, and this new urban generation has become too complacent with the way life is to dig for the truth. So, when injustices or justices occur, their mentality is— “That’s Life! Or “C’est la vie,” which is a way of acknowledging something less than ideal that has to be accepted, because—that's just the way life is. Accept it and grasp the raw and uncanny world that you are about to enter into.

A surreal world filled with relative surprises and uncharted territories that are time and time again explored by verbal conquistadors. Every day of your life—you have seen the world from your perspective. But now, are you ready to view the globe from another person’s viewpoint and not be judgmental? Remember, we are all one, everything is relative and as above so below. That’s Life! *C’est La Vie!* So, in conclusion, I want to end this foreword on a high note with Mel Blanc’s famous catchphrase, “*That’s All Folks!*” Thank you again Chea—for giving me this enormous page to write on, and as we move forward in time—always remember that—no matter what—

“LIBERTY”

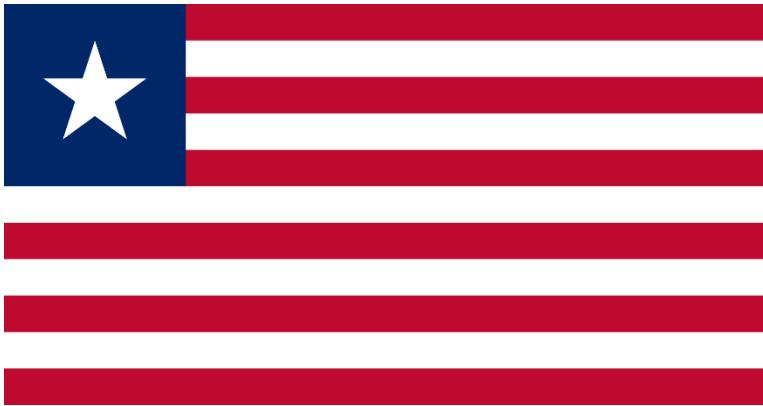
I felt three lashes on my back

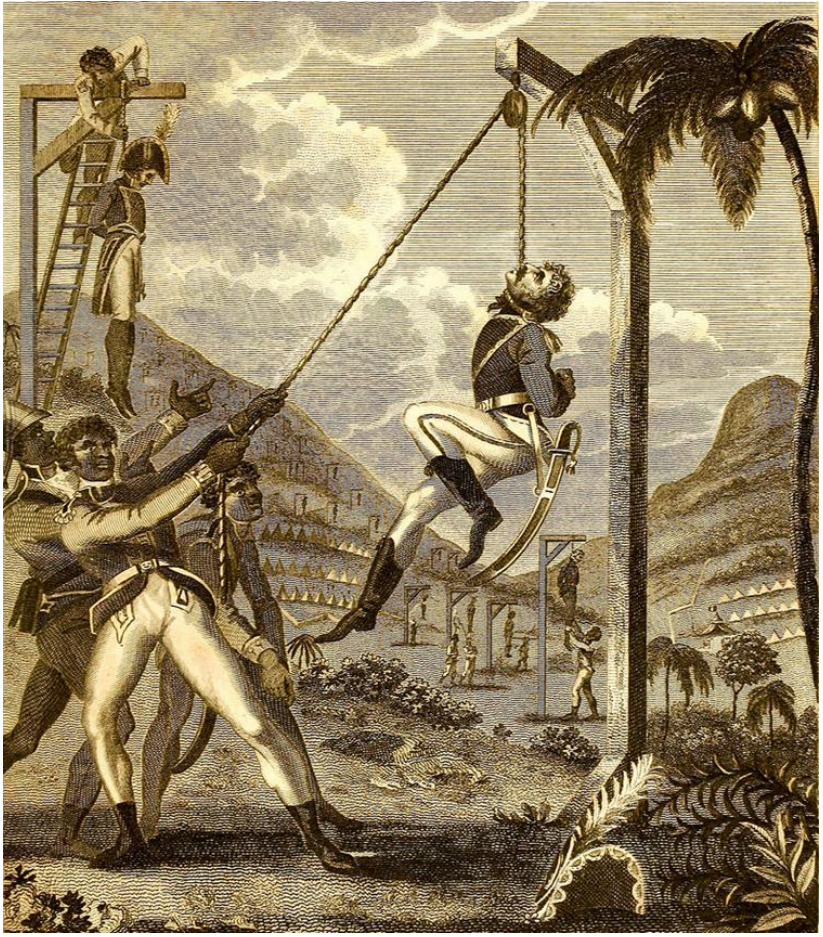

Black Power

Spanish speaking Latin American countries ended slavery between the years 1822-1852 only because Simón Bolívar promised the Haitian revolutionary leader Alexandre Pétion. This promise was to free ALL slaves and Pétion would provide Bolívar with refuge, ships, arms, training, & men to help defeat the Spanish army.

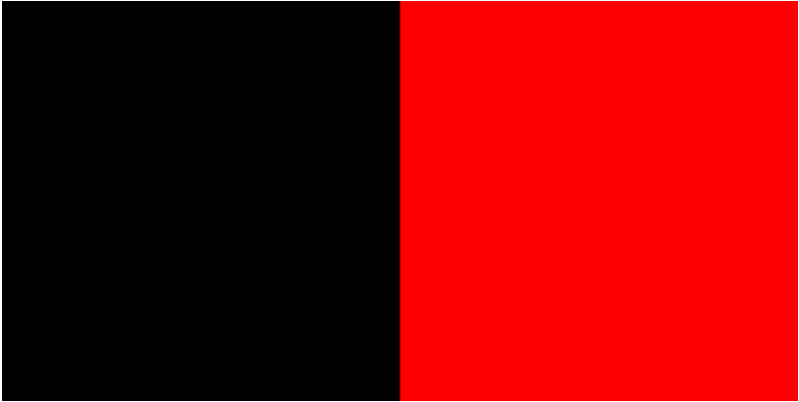
Power was given to those who were born into servitude. Power was taken by those who were born in shackles. Power was created by the community, common language, common spirituality, and the need to be free mentally & physically. When the next revolution comes, be on the right side of history. The idea that "slaves" could rise against the status quo and create a nation, was unheard of. The world didn't realize that these "slaves" were direct descendants of royalty from Dahomey*, other African, & Taino* empires.

USA president Thomas Jefferson & French emperor, Napoleon Bonaparte were enraged that black people could fight and gain their equality as men & women. They didn't believe that black lives mattered. The Dahomey kingdom lasted until 1904. It was in modern-day Benin, Niger, & parts of Nigeria. Dahomeans were known for their intellect & warrior spirit. According to Dahomey customs, women were soldiers as well as providers. These warrior Queens were known as the Mino "our mothers." Haiti's founding father, Jean-Jacques Dessalines was trained by his Dahomey aunt, Tante Toya. She was a former Mino warrior.

The Taino empire was composed of Arawak people spread across the Caribbean. They were the original inhabitants of the island of Haiti & the Dominican Republic before the Spanish & French invaded. The original name of the island was Hayti which means "land of mountains." This name was changed by Columbus but restored after the Haitian Revolution of 1804.
