ADORE CREATIVE, a Los Angeles advertising agency, has a client with global influence, deep pockets, a wealth of resources and an image problem the size of Siberia.

That client is Russia, which many outsiders still associate with spies, the gulag, gangsters, breadlines and permafrost, not to mention retrograde politics.

These are some of the prickly issues that Rupert Wainwright, Adore's president and chief creative director, was hired to deal with when Russian officials approached him in 2007.

"The mission I set for myself was make it fun," Mr. Wainwright said recently at a Moscow cafe, a freezing wind whipping down the street outside.

"The big issue with Russia is, you have to normalize it," he said. If people see that sense of normalness, he said, "the country will dedemonize itself."

To many Westerners and human rights agencies, the demons still exist, in the form of official corruption, a puppet judicial system and repression of what little political opposition remains. Russia is the most corrupt major economy in the world, according to Transparency International, and Freedom House considers Russia "not free" politically. No project was more challenging for Mr. Wainwright than his first one, the film for Olympic campaign.

Mr. Wainwright presented an upbeat proposal titled "From Russia With Love" that was to end with a crowd of children in Red Square shouting the phrase in English. He said it was met with stone-faced silence by officials, who protested that the title from a James Bond film conveyed cold war espionage.
