

Cattleyas

- Found in tropical Costa Rica south to Argentina in higher altitudes where the air is cool and moist
- Require high light but not direct sun and good humidity
- Temperature: 65 to 85 daytime; 60 or above at night; min 55, max 95
- Pot in well-draining media and let media dry out before watering
- Blooms on cues from temperature difference and day length
- Biggest problems: not enough light and overwatering

Buds from a sheath

- Cattleyas do not go dormant
- Blooms are sensitive to cold drafts and very dry air
