

## Vandas





- Found in tropical Southeast Asia down to Australia
- Firm, fleshy, rigid leaves
- Bloom once per year
- Require very high light, good humidity, warm temperatures
- Temperature: 65 to 95
- Do best in no media or large chunky stuff, roots can exceed 4 feet
- Biggest problems: too much media or low humidity
- Member plants are called "Vandaceous"



Require frequent watering or misting since no media

Vandas are known for their long, brittle roots

Do not like to have roots

disturbed





Grown in wooden or plastic baskets
