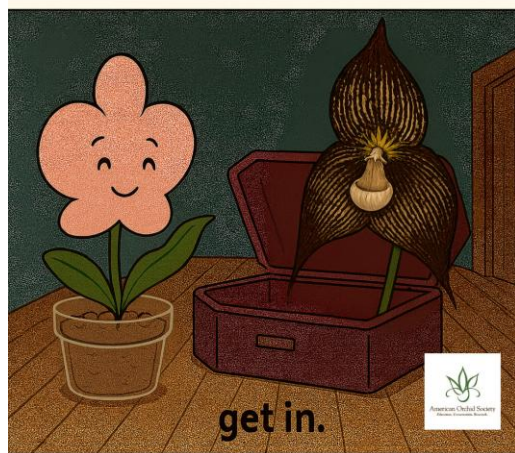
Previous Meeting Minutes

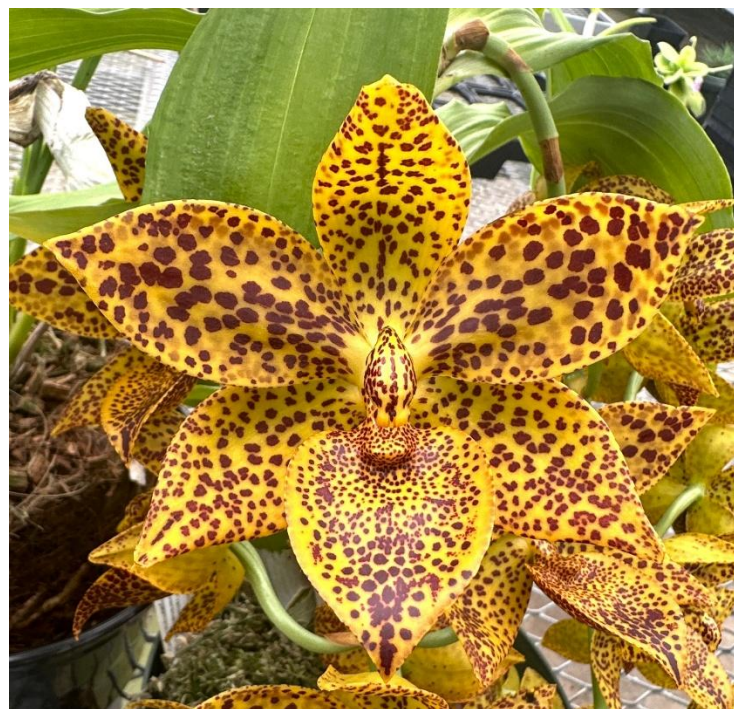
Meeting Schedule

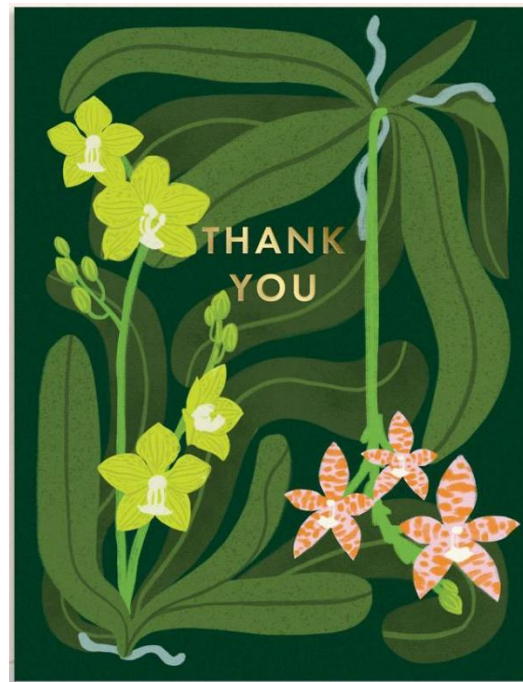

It's officially winter, but don't fear – the putty-root orchid is here! The distinct green and white pin-striped leaf of *Aplectrum hyemale* might be found among leaf litter and snow from fall until early spring in the eastern to central US and eastern Canada.

The species name "hyemale" comes from the Latin term "hiemalis", meaning "wintry" – a fitting descriptor.

This unique species is the only one in its genus and is critically imperiled in much of its range, including in Quebec, New York, Vermont, Massachusetts, New Jersey, Delaware, and Mississippi.

Please do not disturb wild orchids. – North American Orchid Conservation Center



NEWS from the Great Lakes Judging Center

AOS plant judging takes place the 3rd Saturday each month. Judging is always open to the public and anyone is invited to bring plants for the AOS judges to look at them. AOS awards given are the responsibility of the exhibitor.

Sessions begin at 11 AM Eastern Time with any center business and then an educational talk by judges or other featured speakers. AOS judging begins no later than 1 PM Eastern Time. The Great Lakes Judging Center is responsible for AOS judging in the region spanning Michigan, Northern Indiana, and Northern Ohio.

Judging sessions are held at Washtenaw Community College located at 4800 E. Huron River Dr. Ann Arbor, Michigan 48105. Activities take place in the Morris Lawrence building. Parking is ample and free. Dress is casual and all are welcome to bring lunch or snacks for themselves as no food is provided.

Stubborn Orchids

Blc. Copper Queen (Rlc. Toshi Aoki x Bl. Richard Mueller 4N)

This cross is from H&R and blooms reliably twice a year and has 6 large flowers. I'm very happy with the size and shape and the deep, rich yellow color. Like some Richard Mueller crosses, it has a very slight color change from a pastel orange to yellow as the flowers age. It also has the largest flowers of all my Richard Mueller crosses.



C. Small World 4N x C. Triumphans 4N

This is a new, unregistered cross from H&R between a popular mini catt and a historic primary hybrid. The result is a rather large plant with large flowers is thick substance and a nice fragrance. I am pleasantly surprised with the great coloration of the lip. This is the 2nd blooming with only 1 flower, the 1st having only 2. I am interested to see if future bloomings will produce more flowers or will they be lower in count.



L. itambana x *milleri*

This is a 1st bloom from Diamond Orchids. It opened a deep almost purple red and gradually lightened to a red-orange. Only 1 flower, the size of a quarter, but it lasted almost 6 weeks. These rupicolous laelias are a new favorite of mine because of their tiny plant size and intense color, and I intend to collect a few more.



Vaughnara Golden Spice (Bl. Richard Mueller x Epi. stamfordianum)

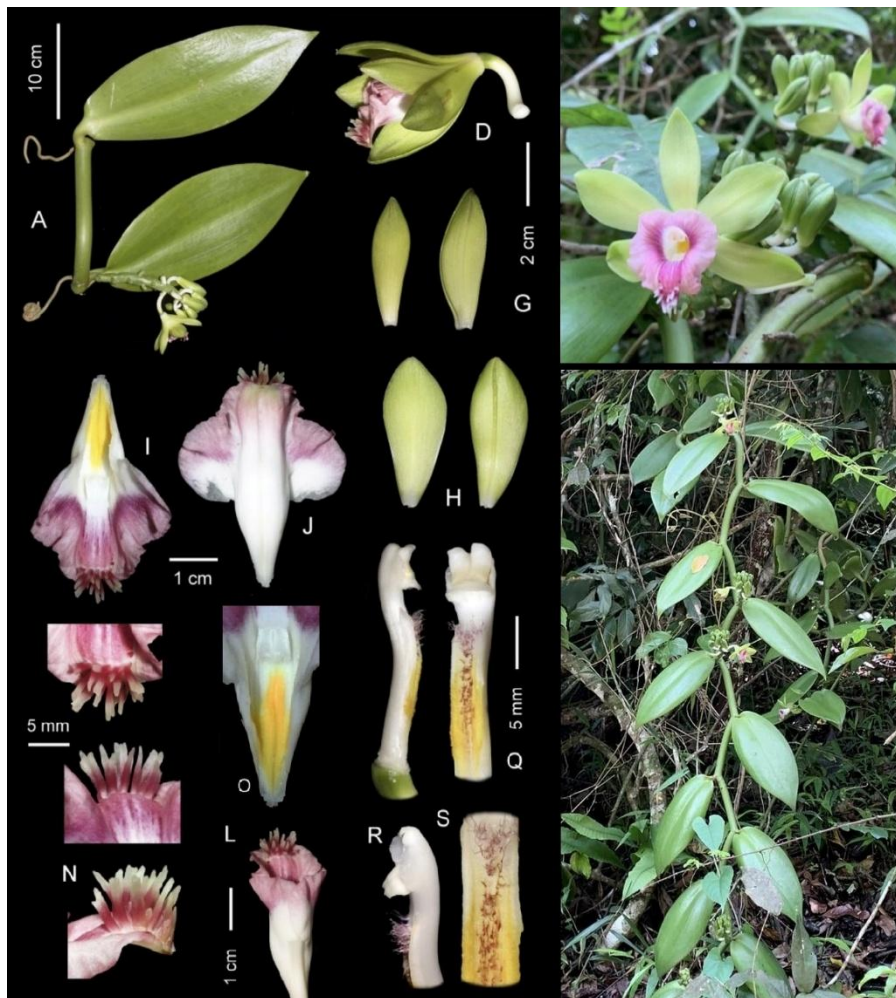
This is a great little hybrid from SVO's 2024 spring release, that has already bloomed several times. The Richard Mueller is a brassavola nodosa hybrid that is great in breeding a smaller more compact plant and in this case, nice spots. These open a pale purple, almost red and finished a bright yellow.

In floral morphology the new species is similar to *Vanilla siamensis* and *V. tiendatii* in having hairs on the apex of the epichile and hairy column. According to IUCN Red List Categories and Criteria *V. baosangii* is assessed as a [#CriticallyEndangered](#).—
