Public Works Report

Gene shared reported that the construction of digester walls for the WWTP are almost completed; just waiting for warmer weather to complete. The lift station in ground and piping has been installed but currently hooked up to other station. Once the new station is completed, they will be switched. There was a water main break. Alliant has 2 poles that were over the break and were moved during repair. These poles were not the cause of the break.

Police Chief Report

Police Chief Bonikowske reported there was 17 calls for service, with 2 citations being issued and 1 arrest. Juneau Co. Sheriff had 50 call and State Patrol had 4. There was a total of 206 calls for service for Police Chief Bonikowske in 2024, 684 for the Juneau Co. Sherrif.

Fire Chief Report

Fire Chief Madland provided a year-end review report. He pointed out that the current year to date fire calls was 80.5 compared to last year's number of 44.5. There were 204 EMS calls.
