#### **Discussion Regarding the Playground Revitalization Project**

Trustee Coley reported that the Village did receive the \$30,000 Love Your Block Grant from Juneau County. A meeting is scheduled on Sunday, October 22<sup>nd</sup> at the park. Flyers were handed out at the Elementary School to inform parents of what it happening. Everyone is invited to attend this meeting as they Village is looking for local input. More flyers will be mailed out to local establishments requesting for Volunteers and/or Donations.

#### **Public Discussion**
