

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Village of Lyndon Station Village Board will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, October 26, 2022 commencing at 6:00 p.m. at the Lyndon Station Village Hall, 116 Lemonweir Street, Lyndon Station, Wisconsin, for the purpose of receiving public comments on the November 8, 2022 Referendum Ballot Question “Under State law, the increase in the levy of the Village of Lyndon Station for the tax to be imposed for the fiscal year, 2023, is limited to 0.816%, which results in a levy of \$68,933. Shall the Village of Lyndon Station be allowed to exceed this limit and increase the levy for the fiscal year, 2023, for the purpose of addressing village personnel needs, potentially including a full time clerk, two additional trustees, additional public works personnel, and a part time police officer, by a total of 253.871% which results in a levy of \$243,933, and on an ongoing basis, include the increase of \$175,000 for each fiscal year going forward.

Any interested person or his/her agent will be heard at this public hearing?”
