§ 288-1. License required.

Every person who shall engage in the business of a peddler, hawker, house-to-house salesman, solicitor or transient merchant must obtain a license from the Village President or Village Clerk-Treasurer before engaging in said business in the Village of Lyndon Station.

§ 288-2. License fees.

The license for any of the above business endeavors shall be granted upon the payment of \$5 for each manager and \$3 for each helper.

§ 288-3. Violations and penalties.

Any person violating the provisions of this chapter shall be subject to a forfeiture of not less than \$1 nor more than \$25 for each offense and the costs of the proceedings and upon default in the payment of the forfeiture and costs shall be imprisoned in the county jail of Juneau County, Wisconsin, until such forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding 10 days.

§ 288-4. Separate offenses.

Every sale, or attempted sale, by any person coming within the provisions of this chapter who has not first obtained a license shall be a separate offense and each violator shall be subject to the penalty provided herein for each such offense.
