*****WINTER PARKING REMIDER*****

The Winter Parking ordinance is in effect. Please plan accordingly for your winter parking options. Thank you.

Village of Lyndon Station Ordinance SS296-12 Winter Parking;

Winter parking regulations will be in effect from **December 1st to April 1st**. The purpose of these regulations is to assure that the streets in the Village can be properly maintained for the safety and convenience of everyone. Owners of vehicles need to use off street parking.

No vehicle may be parked on the street for more than 24 hours without being moved. If off street parking is unavailable between the hours of 2:30AM and 7:00AM, vehicles must be parked on the even side of the street on even numbered calendar days and on the odd side of the street on odd numbered calendar days.

It is prohibited to park on the following streets between 2:30AM and 7:00AM on any day during the winter parking months **1 December – 1 April**.

- **Wisconsin Street (from the Railroad tracks to Prospect Street)**
- **Flint Street between Lemonweir & Juneau Streets**
- **North Juneau Street**
- **North Lemonweir Street**
- **North Side of Julius Street**

Tickets will be issued for Winter Parking violations with fines up to \$150.00.

In addition to being ticketed, a vehicle that is parked illegally may be towed at the owner's expense.
