The critical question: Why did Messiah call Himself the Son-of-Man? The most widely accepted answer to the question is that the Son-of-God Jesus Christ is born as a human in this world; therefore, He is known as the Son-of-Man.

Is this the central reason why Yeshua the Messiah, Jesus Christ, called Himself the Son-of-Man?

Yeshua the Messiah said, "Search the Scriptures; for in them you think you have eternal life: and they are they which testify of Me" (John 5:39).

In Luke 24: 25-27, Messiah explained to His disciples concerning Himself from the Torah, Prophets, and Writings [Tanakh or Old Testament].

The secret things belong unto the LORD (YHWH, יהוה) our God (Elohim, אלוהימ): but those things which are revealed belong unto us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this Law (Torah, תורה) (Deut 29:29).

Our following study of the Scriptures unveils the hidden mystery of why Yeshua the Messiah called Himself the **Son-of-Man**. When Messiah called Himself the Son-of-Man, He traveled into the Eternals and showed His divine relationship with His Father YHWH Elohim, and showed His Life and Nature in the Eternals spanning from the eternity past to the eternity future.

Yeshua the Messiah (ישוע המשיח), Jesus Christ, called Himself the Son-of-Man. It is recorded in the book of Mathew 31 times, Mark 13 times, Luke 32 times, and John 11 times. Yeshua the Messiah is identified as the Son-of-Man one time in the book of Acts, two times in the book of Revelation, and one time in the book of Daniel.

The Son-of-Man in Hebrew is "Ben HaAdam, בנ האדם" and in Greek is "Huios Anthropos, υἰός ἄνθρωπος."

In the four Gospels (Good Tidings, Besorah, בשורוה), Messiah called Himself the Son-of-Man 87 times; while, He called Himself the Son-of-God four times. Why?

Let us take a study-journey and find the answer!

Yeshua the Messiah called Himself the **Son-of-God** four times directly.

A complete reading of the following quoted Scriptures will set a platform to understand the spiritual research findings presented in this book. Let us study the following Scriptures diligently.

The Book of Mathew

In the book of Mathew, 31 Scriptures are referenced to the **Son-of-Man**.

- **8:20**. And Jesus saith unto him, The foxes have holes, and the birds of the air have nests; but the **Son-of-Man** hath not where to lay His head.
- **9:6**. But that ye may know that the **Son-of-Man** hath power on earth to forgive sins, (then saith He to the sick of the palsy), Arise, take up thy bed, and go unto thine house.
- **10:23**. But when they persecute you in this city, flee ye into another: for verily I say unto you, Ye shall not have gone over the cities of Israel, till the **Son-of-Man** be come.
- 11:19. The Son-of-Man came eating and drinking, and they say, Behold a man gluttonous, and a winebibber, a friend of publicans and sinners.
- 11:27. All things are delivered unto Me of My Father: and no man knoweth the Son, but the Father; neither knoweth any man the Father, save the Son, and he to whomsoever the Son will reveal Him.
 - **12:8**. For the **Son-of-Man** is Lord even of the Sabbath day.
- **12:32**. And whosoever speaketh a word against the **Sonof-Man**, it shall be forgiven him: but whosoever speaketh against the Holy Ghost, it shall not be forgiven him, neither in this world, neither in the world to come.

Chapter-1

- **12:40**. For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the **Son-of-Man** be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.
- **13: 37**. He answered and said unto them, He that soweth the good seed is the **Son-of-Man**.
- 13: 41-42. The Son-of-Man shall send forth his angels, and they shall gather out of His kingdom all things that offend, and them which do iniquity; And shall cast them into a furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth.
- 16:13. When Jesus came into the coasts of Cæsarea Philippi, He asked His disciples, saying, Whom do men say that I the Son-of-Man am?
- **16:27**. For the **Son-of-Man** shall come in the glory of His Father with His angels; and then He shall reward every man according to his works.
- **16:28**. Verily I say unto you, There be some standing here, which shall not taste of death, till they see the **Son-of-Man** coming in His kingdom.
- **17:9**. And as they came down from the mountain, Jesus charged them, saying, Tell the vision to no man, until the **Son-of-Man** be risen again from the dead.
- **17:12**. But I say unto you, That Elias is come already, and they knew him not, but have done unto him whatsoever they listed. Likewise shall also the **Son-of-Man** suffer of them.
- **17:22**. And while they abode in Galilee, Jesus said unto them; The **Son-of-Man** shall be betrayed into the hands of men.
- **18:11**. For the **Son-of-Man** is come to save that which was lost.
- **19:28**. And Jesus said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That ye which have followed Me, in the regeneration when the **Son-of-Man** shall sit in the throne of His glory, ye also shall sit upon twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.

- **20:18**. Behold, we go up to Jerusalem; and the **Son-of-Man** shall be betrayed unto the chief priests and unto the scribes, and they shall condemn Him to death.
- **20:28**. Even as the **Son-of-Man** came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give His life a ransom for many.
- **24:27**. For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; so shall also the coming of the **Son-of-Man** be.
- **24:30**. And then shall appear the sign of the **Son-of-Man** in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the **Son-of-Man** coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

- **26:24**. The **Son-of-Man** goeth as it is written of Him: but woe unto that man by whom the **Son-of-Man** is betrayed! It had been good for that man if he had not been born.
- **26:45**. Then cometh He to His disciples, and saith unto them, Sleep on now, and take your rest: behold, the hour is at hand, and the **Son-of-Man** is betrayed into the hands of sinners.

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26:64. Jesus saith unto him, Thou hast said: nevertheless I say unto you, Hereafter shall ye see the **Son-of-Man** sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.

The Book of Mark

In the book of Mark, 15 Scriptures are referenced to the **Son-of-Man**.

- **2:10-11**. But that ye may know that the **Son-of-Man** hath power on earth to forgive sins, (he saith to the sick of the palsy,) I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy bed, and go thy way into thine house.
- **2:28**. Therefore the **Son-of-Man** is Lord also of the Sabbath.
- **8:38**. Whosoever therefore shall be ashamed of Me and of My words in this adulterous and sinful generation; of him also shall the **Son-of-Man** be ashamed, when He cometh in the glory of His Father with the holy angels.
- **9:9**. And as they came down from the mountain, He charged them that they should tell no man what things they had seen, till the **Son-of-Man** were risen from the dead.
- **9:12**. And He answered and told them, Elias verily cometh first, and restoreth all things; and how it is written of the **Son-of-Man**, that He must suffer many things, and be set at nought.
- **9:31**. For He taught his disciples, and said unto them, The **Son-of-Man** is delivered into the hands of men, and they shall kill Him; and after that He is killed, He shall rise the third day.
- 10:33. Saying, Behold, we go up to Jerusalem; and the Son-of-Man shall be delivered unto the chief priests, and unto the scribes; and they shall condemn him to death, and shall deliver him to the Gentiles.
- **10:45**. For even the **Son-of-Man** came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give His life a ransom for many.

- **13:26**. And then shall they see the **Son-of-Man** coming in the clouds with great power and glory.
- **13:34**. For the **Son-of-Man** is as a man taking a far journey, who left his house, and gave authority to his servants, and to every man his work, and commanded the porter to watch.
- **14:21**. The **Son-of-Man** indeed goeth, as it is written of Him: but woe to that man by whom the **Son-of-Man** is betrayed! Good were it for that man if he had never been born.
- **14:41**. And he cometh the third time, and saith unto them, Sleep on now, and take your rest: it is enough, the hour is come; behold, the **Son-of-Man** is betrayed into the hands of sinners.
- **14:62**. And Jesus said, I am: and ye shall see the **Son-of-Man** sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.

The Book of Luke

In the book of Luke, 32 Scriptures are referenced to the **Son-of-Man**.

- **5:24**. But that ye may know that the **Son-of-Man** hath power upon earth to forgive sins, (He said unto the sick of the palsy,) I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy couch, and go into thine house.
- **6:5**. And He said unto them, That the **Son-of-Man** is Lord also of the Sabbath.
- **6:22.** Blessed are ye, when men shall hate you, and when they shall separate you from their company, and shall reproach you, and cast out your name as evil, for the **Son-of-Man's** sake.
- **7:34**. The **Son-of-Man** is come eating and drinking; and ye say, Behold a gluttonous man, and a winebibber, a friend of publicans and sinners.
- **9:22.** Saying, The **Son-of-Man** must suffer many things, and be rejected of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be

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slain, and be raised the third day.

- **9:26**. For whosoever shall be ashamed of Me and of My words, of him shall the **Son-of-Man** be ashamed, when He shall come in His own glory, and in His Father's, and of the holy angels.
- **9:44**. Let these sayings sink down into your ears: for the **Son-of-Man** shall be delivered into the hands of men.
- **9:56**. For the **Son-of-Man** is not come to destroy men's lives, but to save them. And they went to another village.
- **9:58**. And Jesus said unto him, Foxes have holes, and birds of the air have nests; but the **Son-of-Man** hath not where to lay his head.
- **10: 22.** All things are delivered to Me of My Father: and no man knoweth who the **Son** is, but the Father; and who the Father is, but the **Son**, and he to whom the **Son** will reveal Him.
- **11:30**. For as Jonas was a sign unto the Ninevites, so shall also the **Son-of-Man** be to this generation.
- **12:8**. Also I say unto you, Whosoever shall confess Me before men, him shall the **Son-of-Man** also confess before the angels of God.
- **12:10**. And whosoever shall speak a word against the **Sonof-Man**, it shall be forgiven him: but unto him that blasphemeth against the Holy Ghost it shall not be forgiven.
- **12:40**. Be ye therefore ready also: for the **Son-of-Man** cometh at an hour when ye think not.
- **17:22**. And he said unto the disciples, The days will come, when ye shall desire to see one of the days of the **Son-of-Man**, and ye shall not see it.
- **17:24**. For as the lightning, that lighteneth out of the one part under heaven, shineth unto the other part under heaven; so shall also the **Son-of-Man** be in His day.
 - 17:26. And as it was in the days of Noe, so shall it be also in

the days of the Son-of-Man.

- **17:30**. Even thus shall it be in the day when the **Son-of-Man** is revealed.
- **18:8**. I tell you that he will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the **Son-of-Man** cometh, shall He find faith on the earth?
- **18:31**. Then He took unto him the twelve, and said unto them, Behold, we go up to Jerusalem, and all things that are written by the prophets concerning the **Son-of-Man** shall be accomplished.
- **19:10**. For the **Son-of-Man** is come to seek and to save that which was lost.
- **21:27**. And then shall they see the **Son-of-Man** coming in a cloud with power and great glory.
- **21:36**. Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the **Son-of-Man**.
- **22:22**. And truly the **Son-of-Man** goeth, as it was determined: but woe unto that man by whom he is betrayed.
- **22:48**. But Jesus said unto him, Judas, betrayest thou the **Son-of-Man** with a kiss?
- **22:69**. Hereafter shall the **Son-of-Man** sit on the right hand of the power of God.
- **24:7**. Saying, The **Son-of-Man** must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again.

The Book of John

In the book of John, 11 Scriptures are referenced to the **Son-of-Man**.

1:51. And He saith unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Hereafter ye shall see heaven open, and the angels of God ascend-

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ing and descending upon the Son-of-Man.

- **3:13**. And no man hath ascended up to heaven, but He that came down from heaven, even the **Son-of-Man** which is in heaven.
- **3:14-15**. And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the **Son-of-Man** be lifted up: That whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have eternal life.
- **5:27**. And hath given Him authority to execute judgment also, because He is the **Son-of-Man**.
- **6:27.** Labour not for the meat which perisheth, but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life, which the **Son-of-Man** shall give unto you: for Him hath God the Father sealed.
- **6:53**. Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, Verily, I say unto you, Except ye eat the flesh of the **Son of man**, and drink His blood, ye have no life in you.
- **6:62**. What and if ye shall see the **Son-of-Man** ascend up where He was before?
- 8:28. Then said Jesus unto them, When ye have lifted up the Son-of-Man, then shall ye know that I am He, and that I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father hath taught Me, I speak these things.
- **12:23**. And Jesus answered them, saying, The hour is come, that the **Son-of-Man** should be glorified.
- **12:34**. The people answered him, We have heard out of the law that Christ abideth for ever: and how sayest thou, The **Son-of-Man** must be lifted up? who is this **Son-of-Man**?
- **12:31**. Therefore, when He was gone out, Jesus said, Now is the **Son-of-Man** glorified, and God is glorified in Him.

The Book of Acts of Apostles

In the Book of Acts of Apostles, one Scripture is referenced to the Son-of-Man.

7:56. And said, Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the **Son-of-Man** standing on the right hand of God.

The Book of Revelation

In the Book of Revelation, two Scriptures are referenced to the **Son-of-Man**.

- 1:13. And in the midst of the seven candlesticks One like unto the Son-of-Man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle.
- **14:14**. And I looked, and behold a white cloud, and upon the cloud One sat like unto the **Son-of-Man**, having on His head a golden crown, and in His hand a sharp sickle.

The Book of Daniel

In the Book of Daniel, one Scripture is referenced to the **Son-of-Man**.

7:13. I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the **Son-of-Man** came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought Him near before Him.

CONCLUSION

The study of these Scriptures provides a platform to find an answer to the question: Why did Yeshua the Messiah (Jesus Christ) call Himself the **Son-of-Man**?

The most common answer to the question is that the Sonof-God Jesus Christ is born as a human in this world, and therefore, He is known as the **Son-of-Man**.

However, it is not the fundamental reason why Messiah called himself the **Son-of-Man**.

In John 12:34, the people answered Messiah, we have heard out of the Torah that Messiah abides forever: How do you

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say, the **Son-of-Man** must be lifted up? Who is this **Son-of-Man**? The people of that age did not understand why the Messiah called Himself the **Son-of-Man**. Even the people of this age neither understand this mystery!

In Mathew 26:63-64, the High Priest asked Jesus, "tell us whether thou be the **Christ (Messiah), the Son-of-God.**" But Jesus answered, "I say unto you Hereafter shall ye see **the Son-of-Man** sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven." In these Scriptures, Yeshua the Messiah has chosen the Title "**The Son-of-Man**" compared to "**The Son-of-God**" when answering the High Priest. Why?

It clearly shows a mystery hidden in the word-pair the **Son-of-Man**, which spans from eternity to eternity. **Indeed, the Son-of-Man is His eternal Name/Title!** Let us continue to uncover this mystery.

Yeshua the Messiah said, "Search the Scriptures; for in them you think you have eternal life: and they are they which testify of Me" (John 5:39).

The secret things belong unto the LORD (YHWH) our God (Elohim): but those things which are revealed belong unto us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this Law (Torah, תורה) (Deut 29:29).

Messiah expounded to His disciples concerning Himself from the Torah, Prophets, and Writings (Luke 24: 25-27).

Together, we will search the Scriptures in detail, unveil the hidden mystery, and find out why Yeshua the Messiah called himself the **Son-of-Man**.
