- Selection Committee will be RIAA members without relation to students being considered for that year's award
- Selection Committee reserves right to meet with finalists before making recommendation to RIAA Board
- RIAA Board members related to eligible students for that scholarship year will recuse themselves from voting on recommended students

- All awards will be announced at the school’s annual awards ceremony or by invitation to a RIAA meeting
- All awards will be paid to school student will be attending
