- Students must complete this Application and submit an Essay on the assigned topic prepared solely by the student;

- Selection Committee will be RIAA members without relation to students being considered for that year's award;
- Selection Committee reserves right to meet with finalists before making recommendation to RIAA Board;
- RIAA Board members related to eligible students for that scholarship year will recuse themselves from voting on recommended students;
- All awards will be announced at the school's annual awards ceremony or by invitation to a RIAA meeting;
