Goals for this week:

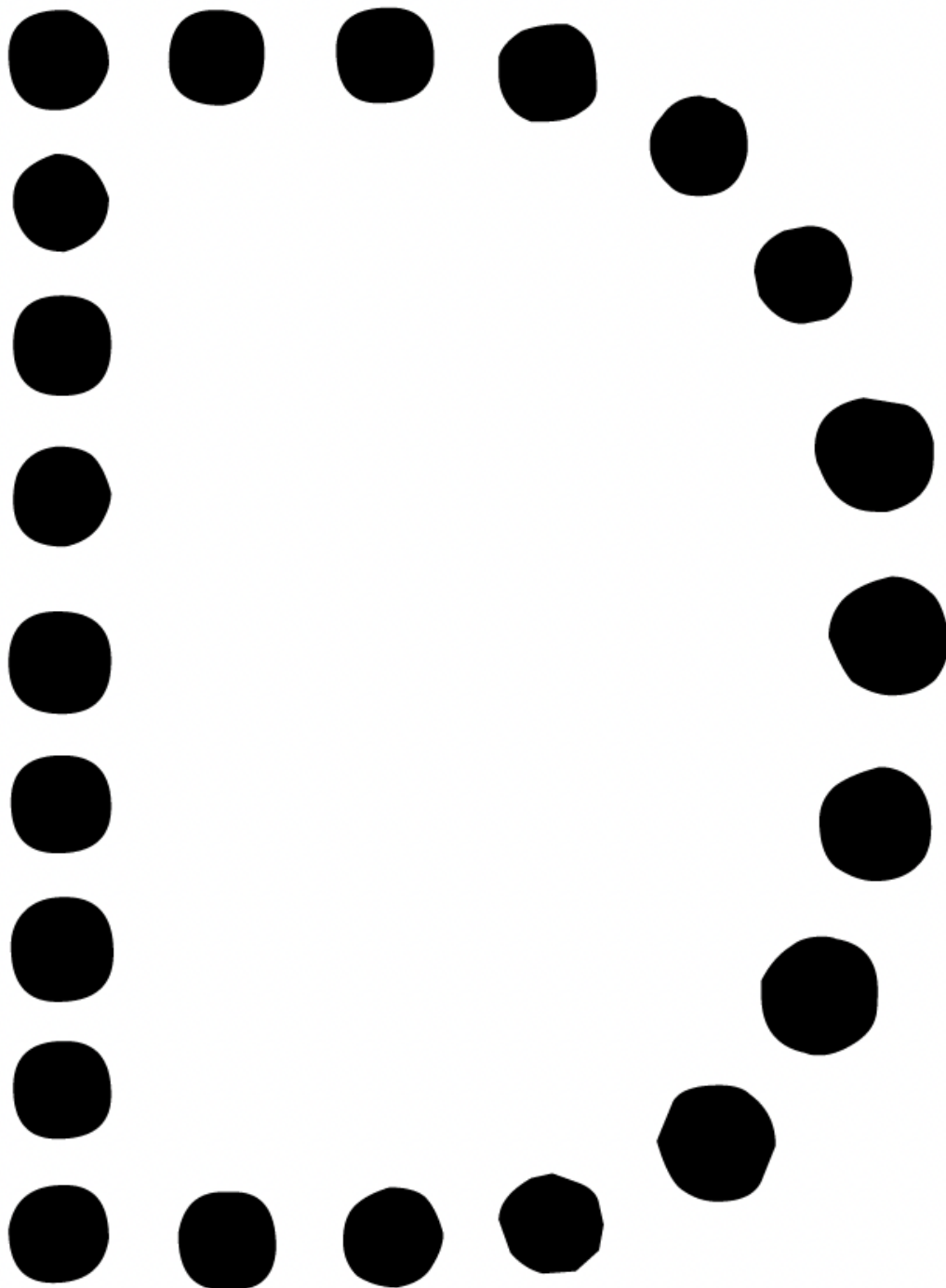
1. Trace the upper and lower case letter D,

4. Make sets of objects that is equal to 6,
5. Recognize objects around them and start naming things that are orange,
6. Trace, cut and make their own heart shapes,
7. Make logical connections while working with patterns,
8. Recognize rhymes using pictures while reading after the teacher,
9. Develop phonemic awareness through pictures.

Domains and skills developed:

1. Fine motor skills: Tracing, writing, drawing, cutting, and coloring
2. Social & emotional: Identifying, observing, and naming things that they see around them
3. Cognitive: Recognize numbers, letters, colors, and shapes
4. Language & communication: Talk about their favorite color and shape, developing simple answers to simple questions, naming the four kinds of weather
5. Physical: Action songs and reciting nursery rhymes

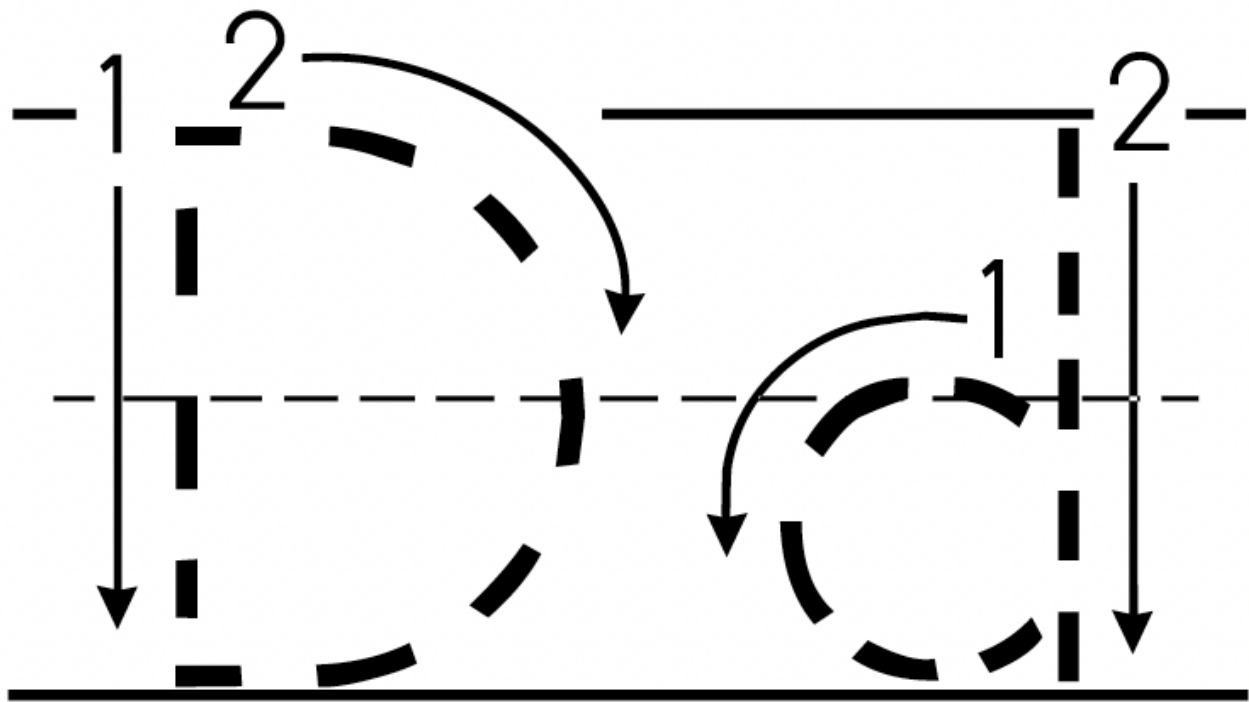
