"How do early relationships with family and friends build the emotional and social foundation for a child's entire life?"

Young children should be aware of friends and family early in life because these relationships build the core foundation for emotional security, empathy, social skills, and confidence. Recognizing and interacting with people around them helps kids understand the world and their place in it.

Strong friendships can help young children build good conflict resolution skills. With both acquaintances and close friends, conflict is bound to arise from time to time. Good relationships will also increase your child's self-esteem, which will increase their independence even more.

As always, the behavior you model will have a strong influence on your child. Let your child see you nurturing your own relationships, and they will be able to learn from your example.



Lesson Targets for the Week

This week's lesson will be exciting for our children will be learning about how to build relationships with you, with other adults and the new friends they just met in school. For children, relationships are the foundation upon which everything grows. Their overall development - intellectual, social, emotional, physical, behavioral, and moral - is affected by the relationships they have with others in their lives. They will be learning more about how to keep friends This week they will learn some word patterns, sounds of words, repetition and rhymes! There will be writing and more of exercising our tongue and counting how many letter sounds are in a word. This will help them develop strong letter recognition, sound them out and forming words.

Goals for this week:

- 1.Trace the upper- and lower-case letter U,
- 2.Recognize object names that begin with the letter U,
- 3.Match pictures and name words with initial "U",
- 4.Make sets of objects that is equal to 13,
- 5.Recognize pink objects around them and start naming them,
- 6.Trace, cut and make their own rectangles,
- 7.Make logical connections while working with patterns,
- 8.Recognize rhymes using pictures while reading after the teacher,
- 9.Develop phonemic awareness through pictures and,
10. Develop listening skills during read aloud.

Domains and skills developed:

Fine motor skills: Tracing, writing, drawing, cutting, and coloring

Social & emotional: Identifying, observing, and naming things that they see around them

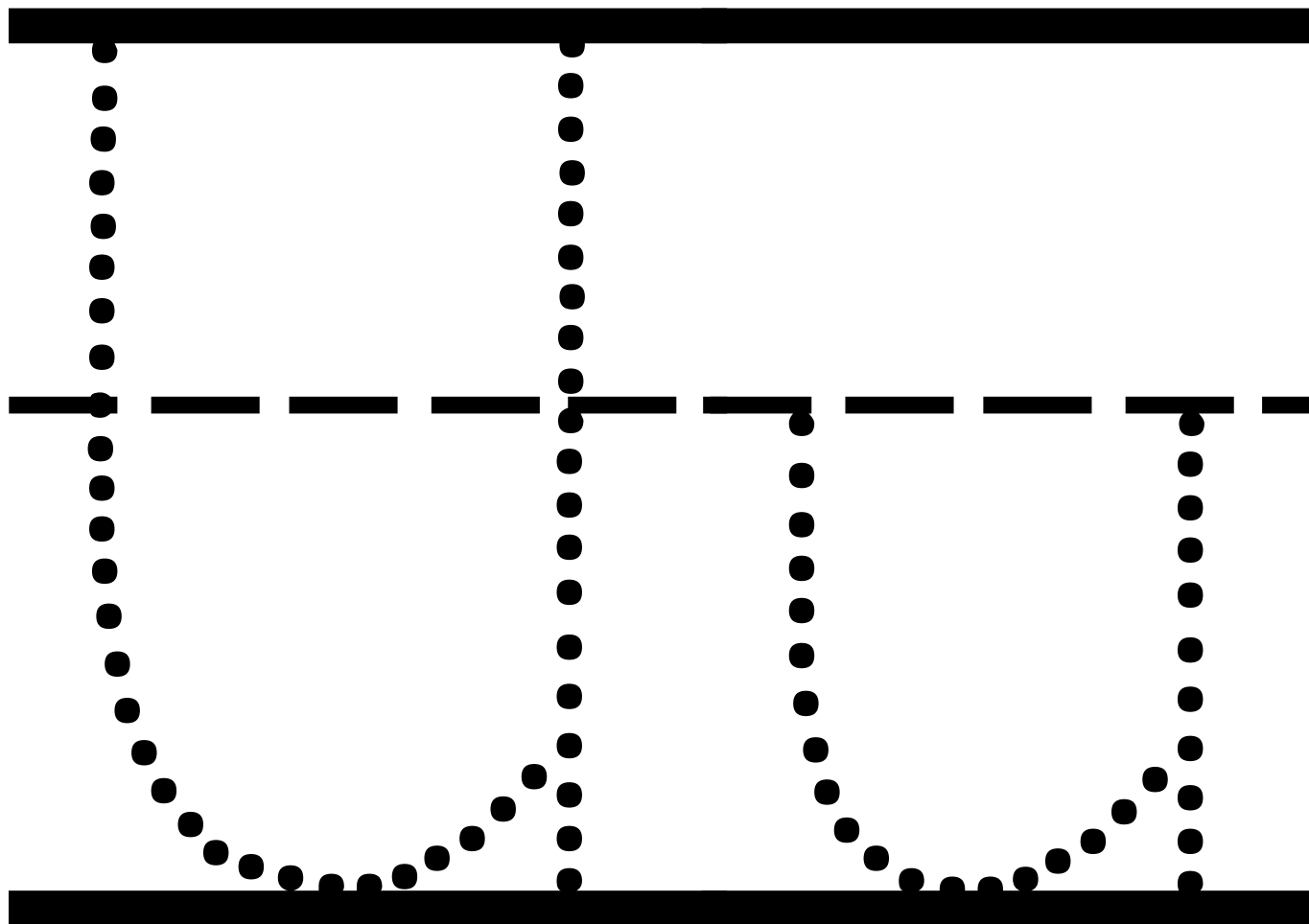
Cognitive: Recognize numbers, letters, colors, and shapes

Physical: Action songs and reciting nursery rhymes

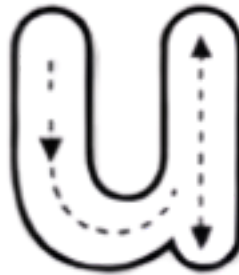
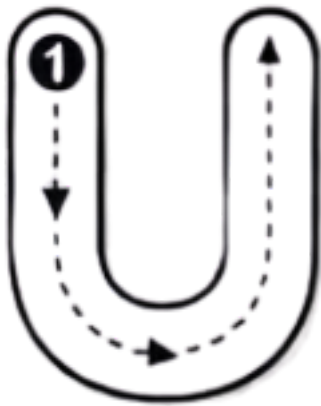
