Because pumpkins engage all five senses in a unique way and provide a multi-sensory, hands-on learning experience for young children, there's seamlessly connect multiple subjects like science, math, literacy, and motor skill development. It will also be beneficial that children can feel the smooth exterior skin, the rough stem, and the gooey, stringy "guts" inside. This messy tactile play helps with sensory processing and self-regulation. They can also smell the distinct aroma, hear the hollow sound when tapping a whole pumpkin, and taste pumpkin treats.



Lesson for this Week

This week's lesson will be as interesting and highly recommended. We will be learning about patterns, sounds of words, repetition and rhymes! We will be learning more about pumpkins and how to grow them. There will be less of writing but more of exercising our tongue and counting how many letters in a word. This will help you develop strong letter recognition, sound them out and forming words

Goals for this week:

- 1.Trace the upper- and lower-case letter P,
- 2.Recognize object names that begin with the letter P,
- 3.Match pictures and name words with initial "P,
- 4.Make sets of objects that is equal to 13 using groups of 10,
- 5.Recognize orange objects around them and start naming them,
- 6.Trace, cut and make their own circles,
- 7.Make logical connections while working with patterns,
- 8.Recognize rhymes using pictures while reading after the teacher, and
- 9.Develop phonemic awareness through pictures.

Fine motor skills: Tracing, writing, drawing, cutting, and coloring

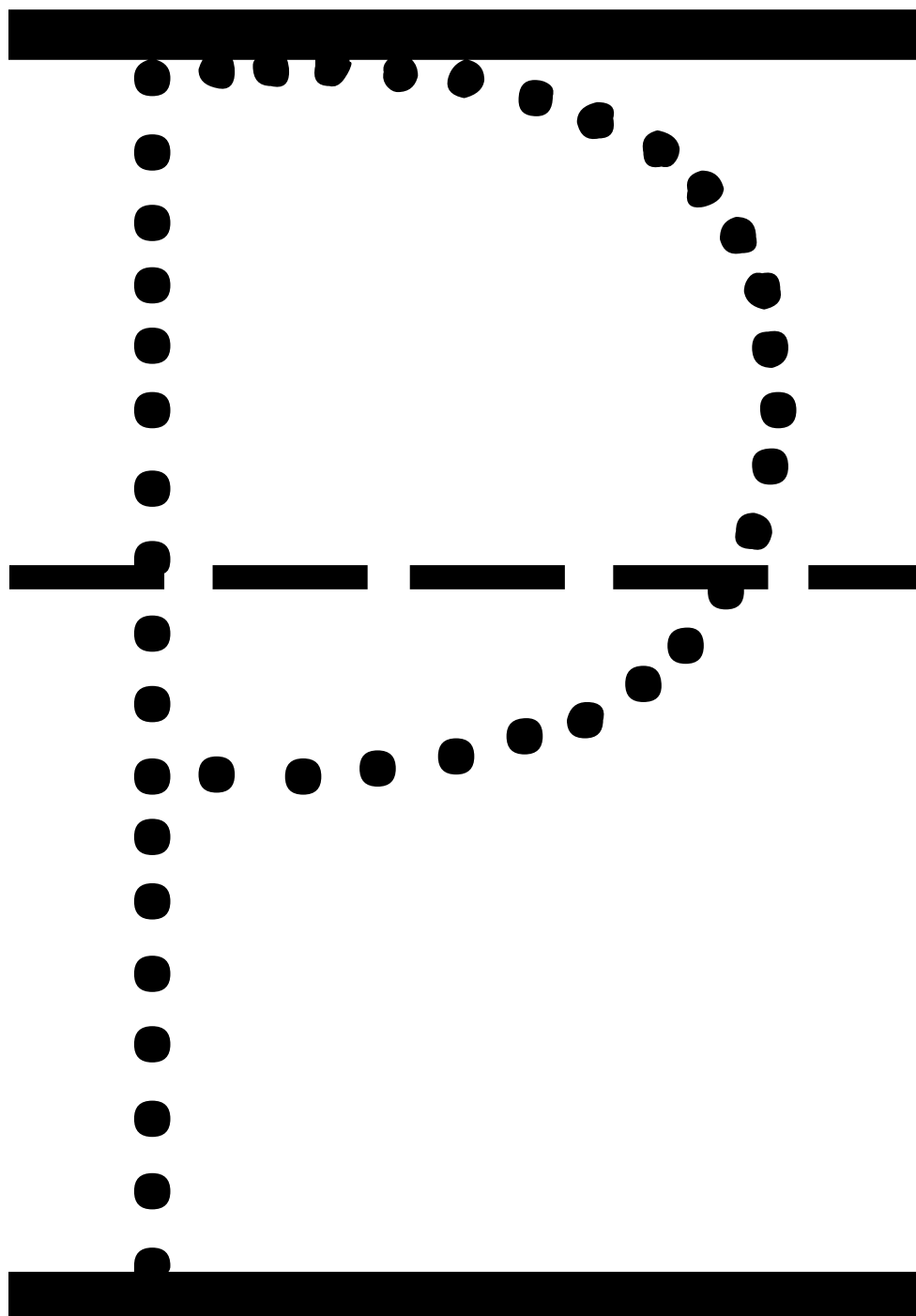
Social & emotional: Identifying, observing, and naming things that they see around them Cognitive: Recognize numbers, letters, colors, and shapes

Physical: Action songs and reciting nursery rhymes

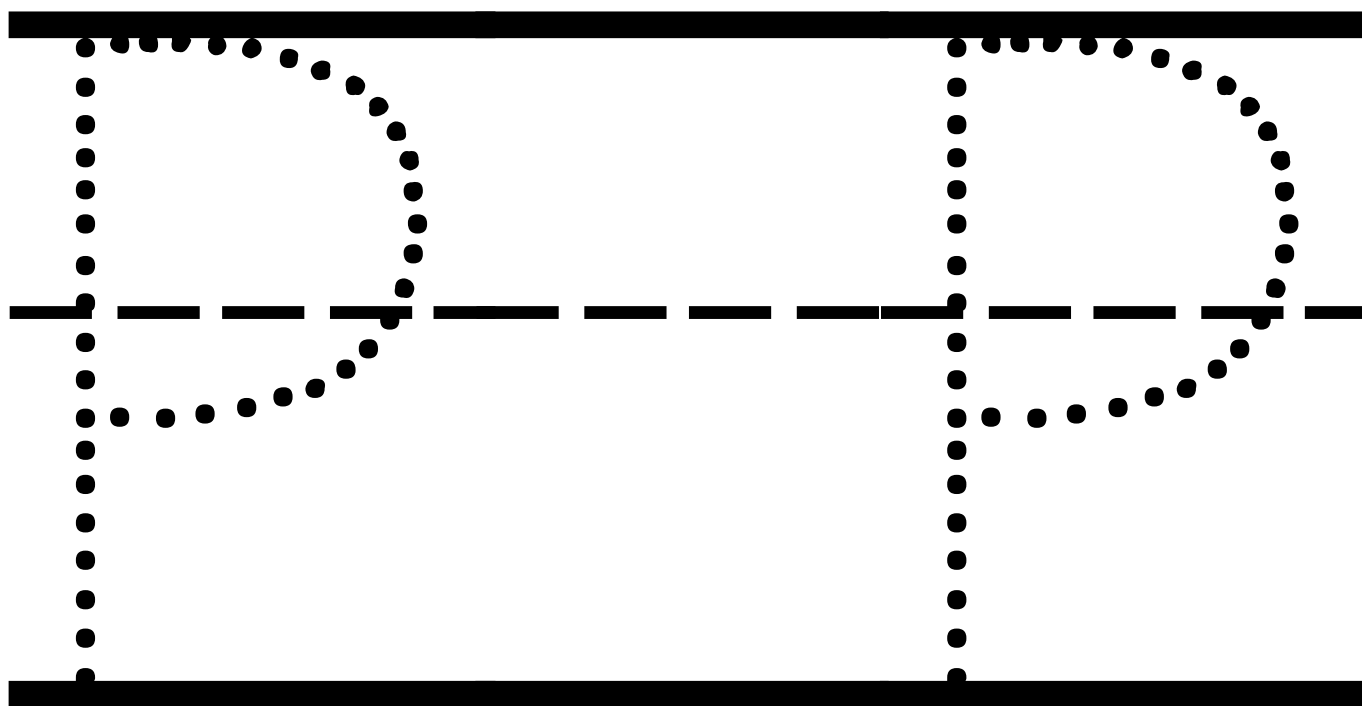
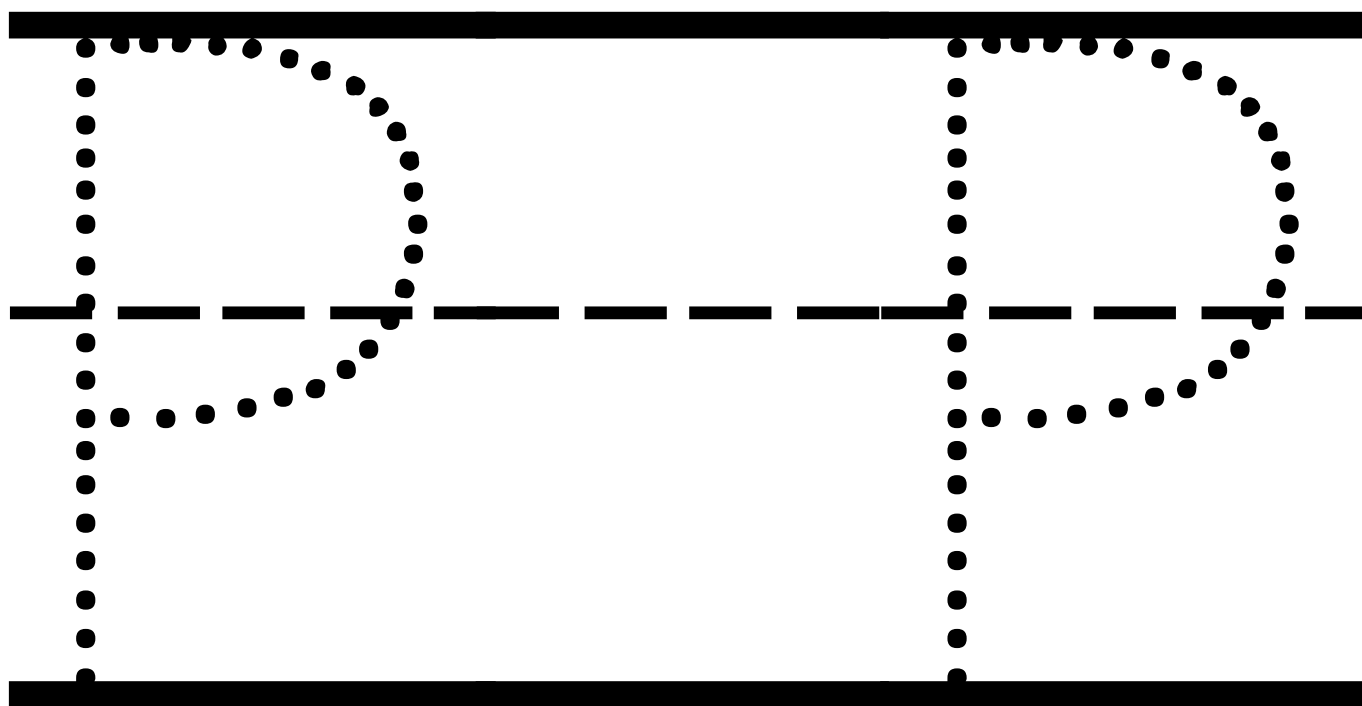
