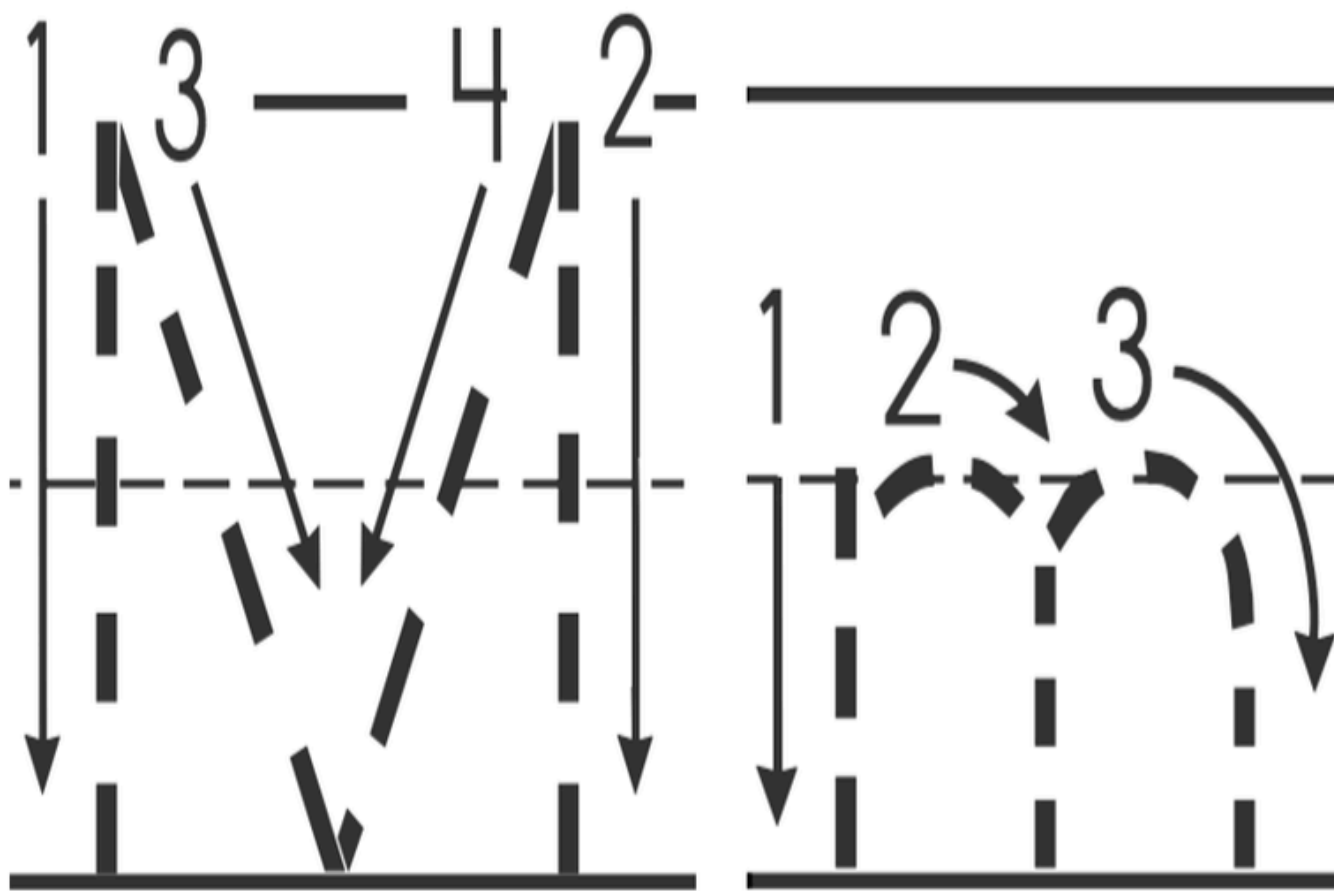
Why should young children learn about leaves?
