



- Spending minimum: 20% of membership dues (\$206). Must be spent annually between March 1 and February 28. Any remaining balance will be invoiced. Eligible purchases include all Food & Beverage and Pro Shop purchases. <u>Does not include:</u> Carts, Simulator, and Guest green fees
- May purchase up to 5 additional rounds after September 1st for \$80 plus HST each

### **Century**


- Must be at least 75 years of age and have been a Brightwood member for 25 Years
- Eligible to play Three rounds per week on weekdays only
- Spending minimum: 20% of membership dues (\$451). Must be spent annually between March 1 and February 28. Any remaining balance will be invoiced. Eligible purchases include all Food & Beverage and Pro Shop purchases. <u>Does not include:</u> Carts, Simulator, and Guest green fees

#### **Social Playing 10 - Century**

- 10 rounds of golf
- Unrestricted tee sheet access on weekdays
  - Restricted tee sheet access on weekends/holidays. Play after 1:00PM
- Spending minimum: 20% of membership dues (\$175). Must be spent annually between March 1 and February 28. Any remaining balance will be invoiced. Eligible purchases include all Food & Beverage and Pro Shop purchases. <u>Does not include:</u> Carts, Simulator, and Guest green fees

- Rounds may be split among no more than two adult members living at the same residence
- Unrestricted tee sheet access weekdays
- Restricted tee sheet access on weekends/holidays. Play after 1:00pm
- Age 19 or older as of June 1, 2025
- One Junior included. 2nd Junior \$150 plus HST, 3rd Junior \$75 plus HST (Playing terms apply)
- Spending minimum: 20% of membership dues (\$383). Must be spent annually between March 1 and February 28. Any remaining balance will be invoiced. Eligible purchases include all Food & Beverage and Pro Shop purchases. <u>Does not include:</u> Carts, Simulator, and Guest green fees



- Unlimited golf
- Unrestricted tee sheet access weekdays
- Restricted tee sheet access on Weekends/holidays. Play after 1:00 PM
- Age 19-24 As of June 1, 2025
- Spending minimum: 20% of membership dues (\$304). Must be spent annually between March 1 and February 28. Any remaining balance will be invoiced. Eligible purchases include all Food & Beverage and Pro Shop purchases. <u>Does not include:</u> Carts, Simulator, and Guest green fees
- Must currently be enrolled in a secondary education program
- Voting Members



### **Intermediate 20**

- 20 rounds of golf
- Unrestricted tee sheet access weekdays
- Restricted tee sheet access on Weekends/holidays. Play after 1:00 PM
- Spending minimum: 20% of membership dues (\$210 \$292). Must be spent annually between March 1 and February 28. Any remaining balance will be invoiced. Eligible purchases include all Food & Beverage and Pro Shop purchases. <u>Does not include</u>: Carts, Simulator, and Guest green fees
- Age restrictions apply (see 2025 membership Pricing)
- Non-Voting Member

#### <u>Junior</u>

- Unlimited golf
- Tee sheet Restrictions on weekend/holidays. Play after 3:00PM
- Weekdays may play before 1:00PM or after 6:00PM
- July and August Tee off Window TBD
- Must be age 10-18 as of June 1, 2025
- Non-Voting Members



### **Social Clubhouse**

- Clubhouse access for food and beverage Service and events from March 1<sup>st</sup> February 28<sup>th</sup>
- No golf course playing privileges
- Non-Voting Member

### **Social Spousal**

- Clubhouse access for food and beverage Service and events from March 1<sup>st</sup> February 28<sup>th</sup>
- Must be a Partner of a Social or other member
- CRA's definition of Spouse and Common-Law partner to define partner
- No golf course playing privileges
- Non-Voting Member



# Membership Information

### Membership categories with limited rounds

- Rounds are non-transferable
- Membership dues are subject to HST
- Members may request a change to their membership prior to May 1, 2025.
   Requests will be subject to availability of space within a given membership category
- Member rounds must be used in the season issued. No rounds will be carried forward to any future years. No refunds will be given for unused rounds.
- Members playing the front 8 holes or back 10 holes <u>only</u> will be considered half a round). Should any additional holes be played, it will be considered to be a full round.
- Membership in all categories will be capped by management

### **Tournament eligibility**

- Full Playing, Intermediate, Member 30, Member 20, and Life are eligible to Play in Club Tournaments Individual tournament registration terms may apply
- Member 30, Member 20 and Intermediate 20 Must use one of their rounds for the tournament
- Social Playing 10, all Century, and Family 20 are not eligible to play in the Club
  Championship or interclub events. These members may play in Women's blast off,
  Jim Wilks, Parent & Child, Junior/Senior Mixed two ball, cross country par 3, and Fall
  Freeze. The Member must use one of their rounds
- Corporate members are not eligible to play in club tournaments
- All members must maintain a valid Golf Canada handicap to play in tournaments
- Entry fees may apply for club events and tournaments

### **Guest Privileges**

- Must play with a Brightwood Member and can play a maximum of 3 times per year only
- Tee times for Guests are restricted to after 1:00PM on weekends and holidays; no restrictions throughout the weekdays, only when playing with a member
