### **MEETING MINUTES**

# Milwaukee Philatelic Society Minutes - General Meeting November 5, 2024

Attendance: President Blayne Kirsch, Vice-President Jim Stollenwerk, Secretary MaryAnn Bowman, Treasurer Bob Mather. Directors: Jonathan Kumbera, Chris Proeber, and Gaylord Yost. Absent: Director Bill Gedemer and Past President Dave Hunzicker.

The President called the meeting to order at 6:35 pm.

The minutes from the last meeting were approved by voice vote after discussion regarding the date reported in the minutes for the November meeting. At the time of the October meeting, the November date had been reported to be Monday, November 4, 2024. It was changed later to Tuesday, November 5 (Election Day) upon discovery that the Brookfield Library was not used as a polling place. The minutes are written to reflect the business discussed at the meeting. Elsewhere within the club newsletter, the date was correctly published to reveal the November meeting date.

Copies of the treasurer's report were distributed. MPS is in a strong financial position with three \$5000 CDs, a savings account of \$4973.20, a checking account balance of \$16748.42, and cash on hand of \$132.60. Bob Mather also reported that the insurance company would need the name of the new treasurer for their records. Jim Stollenwerk questioned when the CDs became due but the answer was unknown at the moment.

Several committees made reports. Educational Coordinator Jonathan Kumbera reported that some new books had been donated to the library. Donation committee was revamped with Gary Meyer being asked to relieve his duties as chair. Keith Trischan offered to chair the committee supported by volunteers MaryAnn Bowman, Patrick Dougherty, and Jim Stollenwerk. A standard procedure to document a process for donations is needed.

Old Business: Regarding the large donation recently received, the MPS Board suggested that the donation be accepted and the MPS would pay for a fair market appraisal. This recommendation was brought to the general membership for discussion and a vote. Jonathan made a motion that MPS follow the recommendation of the Board and that an appraisal be made of the material with the appraiser to be selected after receiving three quotes. The motion was seconded and passed.

Holiday Party: December 10, at Alioto's from 6 - 9 pm. Details regarding menu selection are in the newsletter. A minimum of 25 is needed to reserve the room. MPS members and guests to each pay \$20 with the host club paying the remainder. RSVP Gary Meyer with payment by December 5.

Club Auction Process - looking for volunteers to help with auction registration each meeting by 6 pm.

Nominating Committee: Jonathan will again head up the committee. He reviewed the voting process and reminded members that the outer envelope MUST have their membership number in the lower left corner of the envelope. The slate of officers to be elected were all of the incumbents with the exception of Bob Mather (treasurer) whose name will be replaced by Dave Hunsicker on the ballot. Stan Ewert offered to run for a position of Board Director and his name will be added to the ballot.

Upcoming 2025 club meeting dates were announced. There will be three Monday meetings during the upcoming year as our regular Tuesday meeting date was not available.

Members were reminded to pay their 2025 dues.

The door prize winner was Thomas McLinn.

The meeting was followed by the fall major auction.
