

## **Playground Protectors Instructions**

## FOR THE TEACHER:

Once a week, clean up your school grounds or playground area. This is what we recommend.

Break into 3-4 teams. Within the team:

One person will carry a small trash bag One person will record what is found Everyone else will pick up trash

Note: Children picking up trash should wear gloves.

Each team can spread out and clean a certain location.

When they put an item of trash in the bag, they call out what it is. The data recorder can then make a tally mark in the correct category.
