

Draw a Life-Sized Whale or Dolphin!

Below you will find a picture of a right whale and a picture of a dolphin. All you need is some chalk and a long string/yarn to draw them life size. Here's how you do it! (This might be a fun activity for the whole class!)

First, draw the larger rectangle. For the right whale, it's 50 ft by 20 ft. The dolphin will be 10 ft by 4 ft. Then add the smaller squares. For the right whale, each square should be 5 ft by 5 ft. For the dolphin, each square should be 1 ft. by 1 ft. You might want to use the sting and a measuring tape the draw it to make sure your lines are straight.

Once you have your grid, you are ready to start drawing the whale! Take each square at a time and draw what is in it. For example, look just at square B1 and draw that in the B1 space on the blank grid. This might take a while. Have fun! Send a picture to team@thewhalemobile.com
