NRA Basic Range Safety Officer Course

Saturday June 25, 2022, 8:00 a.m. EST

Purpose

"During the 1980s, many shooting organizations, clubs, and ranges had determined that their facilities needed to be operated by NRA Certified Instructors or Coaches due to the lack of training specifically for range safety personnel.

In response, the National Rifle Association developed the Basic Range Safety Officer Course in 1998 to satisfy the need to have trained persons oversee and conduct safe range operations without the necessarily being NRA Certified Instructors or Coaches. Successful completion of the course will result in NRA Range Safety Officer certification.

This course of instruction is designed for persons who have been assigned by a range owner, operator, or manager to oversee range safety. Course contents include: ensuring the range is safe to use; conducting range safety briefings for shooters; handling ammunition and firearm malfunctions safety; supervising safety aspects of shooting activities; and handling emergency procedures as established by the range management.

This course does not encompass the functions and responsibilities of a Range Safety Officer, who conducts NRA Competitive shooting events as defined by Rule 11.5 of the NRA Rule Books."
