



Issues/Concerns






- Monday, Wednesday, Thursday

- Attendance taken by team moms
- If player misses 30 minutes of practice, they are considered absent..


- If player is late to 2 practices in one week, this will count as one absence.
- If a player is present, but is choosing not to fully participate, they will not be counted present.
- Each participant must participate in at least two practices in order to be eligible to play. Missing one practice two weeks in a row results in not playing during the next game.



- Excused absences from a game/practice are: a death in family, illness with a doctor's note as verification, prior approval for a religious obligation, or a required school sponsored function
- No drop offs allowed. Parents need to stay on premises.
- First aid kits and AED are available at all practices.
- If lightning strike is within a 10 mile radius, everyone must immediately return to their vehicles for 30 minutes. With every lightning strike (within the 10 mile radius) ,the 30 minute clock resets.
- If practice is cancelled due to weather, we will try to make up Tuesday or Friday of that week.



- Game day CANNOT happen without volunteers!!
- Times: Flag 8 AM, Freshmen 9 AM, Sophomore 10:30 AM, Junior 12 PM, Senior 1:30PM (*subject to change!*)
- Klein Oak is our Home Field
- Players need to be in uniform, ready and in time for weigh ins (at the end zone), usually about 1 hour before game time.
- No smoked visors allowed. These will result in your player being removed from the game.
- White Game day socks only.



- There are a minimum number of plays for each player depending on the number of players on the roster
- Referees are paid, but they will make mistakes.Parents are not allowed to speak to refs under any circumstances.
- Remember, Team Mom Point of contact,, not coaches.
- Medics will be at games.
- Only those volunteers with lanyard are permitted inside the gate. No cell phone use by anyone inside the gate.
- Concessions will be open at home games.



## Volunteering

- This season **CANNOT** happen without volunteers!
- Team moms will let you know the volunteer spots and descriptions. Home games need more volunteers than away games.
- Team moms will communicate the number of minimum slots you need to sign up for this season. Everyone will have to sign up for a slot
  - (observer and monitor; must be 18+ yrs old)
- To avoid having your volunteer checked cash you need to meet the minimum amount of slots communicated by the team mom. Only exemptions are those who paid the volunteer buyout.



# Looking ahead

- Aug. 10th (9-11AM)- Scrimmage (not a game day) against the Eagles. Half field format.
- Aug 13th Individual and Team pictures. All players will need to take an individual picture, even if you don't plan on purchasing.
- \$75 per player to be collected late August/early September. This goes towards team funds ei. homecoming, end of season party, player goodies, coach gifts, etc.
- Klein Fall break (Oct 14-18) attendance will count! Practice that week will be Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday,
- Homecoming Game dates to be announced at a later time. Homecoming Parade/Pep Rally will most likely be the night before the big games.



## Miscellaneous Items

- Jersey's will be handed out on August 8th
- We have a handful of extra practice pants for any families who need them

- Next season, Klein Oilers will have spots open on the board. Shadowing opportunities available to see if it is something you'd like to do. Speak to a team mom if you are interested.



- Ensure registration is fully paid if you were on a payment plan
- Turn in hold checks (\$250 volunteer, \$200 equipment)
- Pay your fundraiser buyout \$150 (waived if you bring in a sponsor. We LOVE sponsors)
- □ Pay your \$50 equipment fee (tackle only)
- □ Make sure player has practice pants, mouth piece, chin strap and cleats.
- □ Sign Medical release forms (turn into Team mom)
- □ Sign Personal Football Helmet Waiver, only if you are using your own personal helmet (turn into Team mom)
- Purchase spirit wear from the team store! Closes August 1st at 11:59 pm
- Given Sign up for volunteer spots when team moms have that ready.
