First I recommend my soul to the Almighty God who

Secondly I Give and bequeath unto my two youngest
Children Abraham Cropper & Benjamin Cropper (the whole
of My Annuall part or Dividend of My Husband's share
Cropper's Estate here & personal, of what was possessed in
his life time & what was Purchased for the Estate
since his Death, I Give & bequeath the whole of My part
here & personal to My two above named two Children
to them & the heirs of their body, & it is My will &
Desire that if either of My two Children should
Die without Issue or before they arrive to the
Age of twenty One, then in such Case it is My
will & Desire that the whole of his or her Dividend
