



## SAVE WATER. WATER LIKE A PRO.

You can decide whether or not to run your irrigation with the same information our golf course maintenance professionals use when deciding to water the courses.

### Access Georgiaweather.net to determine whether or not to irrigate.

- Go to [www.georgiaweather.net](http://www.georgiaweather.net).
- Under **Weather Stations** on the left side of the home page, select **Skidaway**.
- Go to **Yesterday's Conditions**.
- Look down the list for **Evapotranspiration** data.

If value is *below* .10, reduce irrigation or consider not irrigating.  
If value is *above* .12, irrigate appropriately for the season and in accordance with DNR restrictions.

Evapotranspiration (ET) is a term to describe the amount of water transferred from the soil into the atmosphere through the combined processes of **Evaporation** (*water lost due to normal evaporation from the soil*) and **Transpiration** (*the process of water being lost from the plant, similar in human terms to sweating.*)



The weather station on Magnolia #1 sends data to [georgiaweather.net](http://georgiaweather.net), a network of nearly 80 weather stations throughout the state.
